# Carl's Dye-a-logue

A small, southern church had hired a new preacher. After a few weeks, he called on one of the deacons to lead the closing prayer at a service.

The deacon walked to the front, bowed his head, and slowly began, "Lord, I hate buttermilk." At this, the preacher opened one eye and wondered where this was going.

The deacon continued, "And, Lord, I hate lard." By now the preacher was wondering why he had not been told not to ask this deacon to lead a prayer.

The deacon then said, "And, Lord, I ain't too crazy about plain flour neither. But, when you mix them all together and bake them in a hot oven, Lord, I just love biscuits."

After a momentary pause, he concluded, "Lord, help us to realize that when life gets hard, when things come up that we don't like, whenever we don't understand what You are doing, that we need to wait and see what You are making. After You get through mixing and baking, it'll probably be even better than biscuits. In Jesus' name, Amen."

This is close to what Paul wrote in Romans 8:28, "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose."

Not everything we experience in life is good if experienced by itself. Like the deacon's prayer, we may not like buttermilk (or maybe you do), or lard, or flour individually. We may not enjoy everything life throws at us specifically.

And yet, when you put the above ingredients together, buttermilk biscuits come together. In the same way, as God works to combine all of our life experiences, it all comes together to form something wonderful: your life!

We just need to patiently wait for everything to come together. If we will, then we will see the experiences we have form a rich, abundant life that only God can give us and that Jesus came to this earth, lived and died, to provide (remember John 10:10?).

No matter what is going on now, God will make it work for the good, if we just wait on Him.
