

Carl's Dye-a-logue

Over the next several Sunday mornings, we are going to be engaged in a series of lessons that are designed to make us reflect on a topic that should be very important to each one of us.

When we come together to worship God, what should our attitude be? How many times have we left a worship assembly saying, "You know, I don't know why I bother coming to church . . . I just don't get anything out of it."

Maybe our "consumer mentality" (or attitude, if you will) of making "What's in it for me?" our primary concern is a big part of the problem.

Our worship services are not designed to please us; they are not about what we "get" out of them. They are designed to please God: For He is the object of our worship!

Perhaps we do not get anything out of it because we do not put anything into it! Is it possible that, because we do not try to get anything out of our coming together, we succeed in not getting anything out of our coming together?

Even though God is the focus of our worship, there are some benefits that we receive from our worship of God.

What do we "get" out of the singing? What do we "get" out of the Lord's Supper? What do we "get" out of the prayers? What do we "get" out of the collection? What do we "get" out of the preaching? What do we "get" out of the Bible Classes?

Is there a way we can, perhaps, get MORE out of our assembling together? Is there a way we can leave our times together better than when we arrived? I believe there is!

So for the next few weeks, we are going to talk about "Serving the Lord with Gladness: Getting More Out of ______
