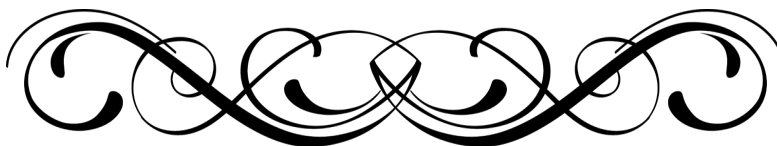

Carl's Dye-a-logue

In 1 Corinthians 10:12 Paul gives a stern warning: "Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall." This past week I was reminded of this in a less than painful way.

Sunday morning about 4:30 I woke up with an excruciating pain in my left side. About 20 years ago I had been awakened with the same pain (oddly enough, also on a Sunday morning). I knew what it was: a kidney stone.

So, Monica and I started for the hospital. On the way, we passed an urgent care center and I decided we should go there instead. So that is what we did.

I can tell you on no fingers how many other patients were there. They got me in before Monica could fill out all the paperwork. I was feeling relief within 15 minutes of walking in the door!

They sent me home with two prescriptions for pain medicine and the hopeful words, "This too shall pass."

On Wednesday, I told those of you who asked that I thought the 3mm stone must have passed because I had not hurt or had to take pain medicine since Monday night.

I do not think that Mr. Stone, Kidney liked me saying out loud that he had left because early Thursday morning the pain started to return. I was able to catch it this time, though, and the pain was "minimal."

Sin is very much like a kidney stone. I thought I had it licked. I thought it had passed. I thought I was in the clear. I was mistaken.

Many times we resist a temptation and think that we are in the clear. We think we sure showed Satan a thing or two with our resistance. We proved what James says in James 4:7, "Resist the devil and he will flee from you" is exactly right. We are so proud of ourselves.

That pride might just be the chink in our armor that Satan is looking for and he pounces and before we know it, we are right back feeling the painful effects of sin in our lives.

So, if you think you are standing firm: watch out that you do not fall!
