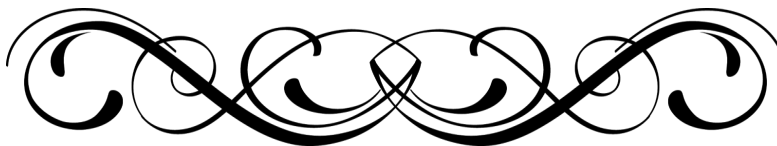

Greetings from Little Rock, AR. Rachel's wedding yesterday came off "with a hitch" and Monica and I now have a son-in-law!

Happy Father's Day to all our dads. Allow me to share with you some information you may not know.

Did you know that the campaign to celebrate the nation's fathers did not meet with the same enthusiasm as the campaign to celebrate mothers did? One florist explained, "Fathers haven't the same sentimental appeal that mothers have."

Washington state celebrated the first statewide Father's Day on June 19, 1910. It was not until 1924, though, that President Calvin Coolidge urged state governments to observe Father's Day.

In the 1920s and 1930s there was a movement to combine Mother's Day and Father's Day into "Parent's Day" to show that both parents were loved and respected.

Oddly enough, during the Great Depression, struggling retailers began to increase efforts to make Father's Day a "second Christmas" for men. This derailed the "Parent's Day" movement.

When World War II began, advertisers began to argue that Father's Day was a way to honor the troops and support the war effort. By the end of the war, Father's Day was a national institution, but still not a national holiday.

It was not until 1972, during a hard-fought re-election campaign, that President Richard Nixon signed a proclamation making the third Sunday in June Father's Day and a national holiday at last. (This information is from: <https://www.history.com/topics/holidays/fathers-day>.)

As Christians, we did not need a President to proclaim a certain Sunday "Father's Day." Each and every Sunday is Father's Day for us. Each and every day is lived for and each and everything is done for the glory of our heavenly Father (see Colossians 3:17, 23, 24).
