

Carl's Dye-a-logue

How do you respond to correction? When somebody points out to you that you are not doing things the way you should, what is your reaction?

For some, if anyone dared to challenge them, they would get angry and accuse the other of "judging me." Others might scoff and say the one seeking to correct them does not know what they are talking about. Still others listen and take the time to reflect on what the other person said. If they feel it is necessary, then they will make the suggested change.

What about when the one seeking to correct you is God Himself? What if as you are studying HIs Word, you realize that you have not been doing something right? What is your reaction then?

I was watching a sermon video this week and the preacher was talking about a "change" they were going to be making as a congregation. He then said that the eldership had studied this topic and the related Scriptures and decided that this "change" needed to be made 15 years ago, but that it really was not the right time 15 years ago to make this "change," so they had put it off until now, 15 years later!

I don't know about you, but if my study of Scripture convicts me and seeks to correct me in any area of my life, the time to make the change is right then . . . not wait for a more convenient time.

In Acts 24:24ff, Paul spoke to Felix about faith in Christ. As Paul reasoned with him about righteousness, self-control, and the coming judgment, Felix was ALMOST ready to make a change in his life . . . But instead told Paul, "Go away for the present. When I get an opportunity, I will summon you" (Acts 24:25). Luke, the author of Acts, never tells us if Felix ever made the change in his life.

My point is that if Scripture really tells us we need to make a change that change should be made immediately. If we put off making the "change" until a more convenient time, maybe it's more a "change" WE WANT to make and not a change Scripture is leading us to make.
