## Carl's Dye-a-logue

First, let me say thank you to the Wrights for another fantastic "Independence Day on the Prairie." I've been able to attend two of the five they have hosted, and I am already looking forward to the sixth-annual

Fellowship is important. It has always been important. This is especially true in the life of the church. We read of the beginning of the church in Acts 2.

Many times, our reading of Acts 2 is confined to verses 37-41 . . . but there are actually six more verses in Acts 2 after verse 41!

Look at what Acts 2:42-47 says:

And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. And all who believed were together and had all things in common. And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

The first Christians got together as often as they could. They opened their hearts and opened their homes to their brothers and sisters. They even had a good reputation with those who were not a part of the fellowship.

The result of this purposeful focus on fellowship was that the Lord added to their number day by day (or "daily") those who were being saved.

How much of a priority do you make fellowshipping with fellow Christians? Fellowship is about being involved in each other's lives. How involved are you in the lives of the family here at Bell? To fellowship, you don't have to have food, just a genuine interest in the well-being of your Christian family
