# Carl's Dye-a-logue

A preacher friend posted a meme this past week that I found intriguing. It said:

The men who couldn't pray one hour with Jesus were the same men who had no trouble fishing all night. Priorities matter. If you want to go to church you will. The reason you don't is because you don't want to. People do what they want.

There were a few replies to it. Some were favorable, some warned that we should be careful in judging other people's heart.

A few weeks ago, we talked about the disciples in the garden and how overwhelmed with sorrow they must have been at the close of the final week of Jesus' life on earth. My point was that their flesh was willing, but their spirit was weak.

The point of the meme is the last three sentences. If we WANT to do something, we will find a way to do it. If we have a rough week at work and anticipate an equally rough week to come, many times we see that as a reason to stay at home on Sunday and rest, rather than attend services at church.

Let's change the scenario a little bit. You have the same rough week and the same outlook for the next week. However, imagine that AA baseball instituted a championship game (similar to the one for AAA, which equates to the minor league version of the World Series). Now imagine that the championship game was going to be played Sunday. Now imagine that not only is the game at Hodgetown, but the Sod Poodles are playing in the game . . . and you, a season ticket holder, have won a drawing and been upgraded to a club level suite.

As an avid baseball and Sod Poodle fan, are you going to let your exhaustion and dread of the next week of work keep you from attending the game?

So why would you let exhaustion and dread keep you from joining your brothers and sisters in Christ for a couple of hours on Sunday?

You will find a way to do what you WANT to do. The real question is, "Do you WANT to be here?"!
