### Carl's Dye-a-logue

Attic Theory. This theory proposes that the brain is like an attic and, thus, has limited storage space. You can choose to fill that space with important things or unimportant things; but once you reach your limit of storage space,

you cannot remember anything else (without letting go of other information).

Is it true? I really do not know. Is it even a real theory? I saw it professed by a character in a television show I enjoyed so much I now own all seven seasons on DVD. So, again, I really do not know.

Why would I tell you about it, if I do not even know if it is a real thing? Because of its application to other areas of our lives . . . specifically time management.

When something is important to you, you will make time to do it, regardless of what else you might need to do. If there is a conflict, you must prioritize what is most important to you. You have to decide what you want to spend your time doing.

While I do not know if Attic Theory is true of the brain, I do know it is true of time. We have a limited amount of time each day. Each day is 24 hours long or 1,440 minutes or 86,400 seconds. Once that time has elapsed, the day is over.

We must manage our time so that the important things get done. For many, work is their top priority. They spend 40+ hours each week working. For many people, work squeezes out other things that we need to be doing.

For others, the kids are the top priority. The kid's activities take precedence over everything else. Our kids are involved in so many activities, we spend every waking moment taking them where they need to go. For many people, their kids' activities squeeze out everything else.

I could go on, but my point is this: if you do not prioritize your relationship to God, it will be replaced with something else. Perhaps work or activities (things that are good) will squeeze out God.

Make sure you prioritize God over everything else. Do not let other things interfere with your relationship to God. Make your daily time of prayer and study the most important part of every day. On Sunday and Wednesday, make it a point to attend every service of the church possible (there will be exceptions: God knows, and He understands... just be sure the exceptions do not become the rule).
