

Did you know that you have a tremendous power within you to impact other people? Well, you do! Just by the way you speak to someone you can cause

them to either relax or strained.

I have a challenge for you. Today, when you are talking to someone, find something to compliment them on. It can be something they are wearing, the way their hair is done, their attitude, their nails . . . just find some way to pay them a compliment.

Naturally this challenge starts now, this morning here at Bell. This should be easy as you meet and greet your brothers and sisters in Christ.

As you progress through the day, though, it may become a little more difficult. When you get to the restaurant and the line is already "a mile long;" when you finally are seated, and it takes the waitstaff more than a minute to greet you and take your drink order; when your order comes and it is not what you expected (or ordered) . . . it becomes a lot tougher to give out compliments.

What about when you get home and are trying to rest, but the kids are making a racket and, well, you really want to tell them "please be quiet" but in a little firmer way?

Fast forward to tomorrow morning. You get to work, and your boss is cranky because he/she had a miserable weekend. If you respond with a genuine compliment, how could that change their mood?

How about sending a note or text to your child's teacher or teachers thanking them for what they do and telling them you are looking forward to a great school year?

Make passing out compliments second nature. Be grateful for the small things that others do for you. Say "thank you" when they do those things, no matter how seemingly insignificant.

Who knows? Perhaps that compliment can change the way a person's day is going. Perhaps it might even open a door for the gospel.
