## Carl's Dye-a-logue

In Shakespeare's "Julius Caesar," the title character is warned by a soothsayer: "Beware the Ides of March!" (Act 1, scene 2) Caesar, of course, pays the soothsaver no mind . . . but by the end of the play, he learns that he should have paid attention.

I guess that if a "soothsayer" were to warn me, he or she would say, "Beware the twentieth of August!"

A year ago, on August 20, I had a heart attack. Last Sunday night (which was August 20) we had to take Jamie to the emergency room after services. She was admitted to the hospital and was released on Tuesday with yet another medical diagnosis . . . to go along with all her other medical diagnoses.

The website dictionary.com defines superstitious as: "of the nature of, characterized by, or proceeding from superstition -(superstition is "a belief or notion, not based on reason or knowledge, in or of the ominous significance of a particular thing, circumstance, occurrence, proceeding, or the like").

While I am NOT superstitious, I do believe that next August 20 will be approached with extreme caution for my family . . . particularly for Monica, Rachel, and Austin.

There is, however, another day that is approaching that we are warned about: not by Shakespeare, or any other author, but by Jesus Himself. While Caesar was warned about March 15 and I may be cautious about August 20, Jesus does not even know the date of which He warns us.

In Matthew 24:36, Jesus says, "But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only."

While He had been talking about "those days," (the fall of Jerusalem in 70 A.D.) now He speaks of "that day," the final one. The day when He returns to retrieve His bride, the church (see 2 Corinthians 11:1, 2; Revelation 19:7).

Since we do not and cannot know the day when Jesus will return, we must be constantly ready for Him to return (see the parables in Matthew 25). We must be prepared so "that day" is not a day of doom for us, but a day of rejoicing!
