Fasting in the Old Testament

Carl's Dye-a-logue

For many if not most of us, when we go to the doctor for a checkup, lab work is required. Many times, the doctor or nurse will remind you to fast before having

your blood work done. For a lot of us, that is the extent of what we know about fasting . . . it's about not eating before labs are drawn so that recently eaten food does not skew the results.

But is that all fasting really is? Should we only fast for medicinal reasons?

Beginning tonight, we are going to explore the rarely talked about subject of fasting. We will begin by looking at "Fasting in the Old Testament."

In two weeks, we will look at "Fasting in the New Testament." We will conclude in three weeks with "Fasting by Christians Today."

Modern Jews recently celebrated "Yom Kippur." It began at sundown on September 25 and ended at sunset on September 26. Yom Kippur is also the Day of Atonement from our Old Testament.

Those of the Jewish faith and those familiar with Old Testament teachings on fasting know that the Day of Atonement was the only time the Israelites were commanded to fast.

On Yom Kippur modern Jews are to refrain from eating or drinking, not wear leather footwear, not bathe, not apply lotions or ointments, and refrain from intimate relations. They do (or do not do) all of these on this day to demonstrate their repentance, sincerity, and to show their devotion to God. They also express solidarity with their fellow Jews who are following the same restrictions.

So, a few sermons on fasting are timely from that standpoint. But there is also another occasion that makes it a timely topic.

Soon we will begin the process of appointing additional deacons. Based on what we read in Acts 13:1-3 and Acts 14:23, it might be an appropriate time for us as a congregation to fast.

Does that just mean going without food? Come tonight and find out!
