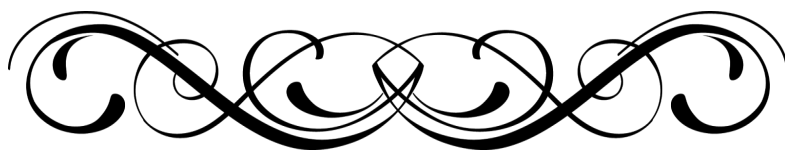

Carl's Dye-a-logue

You may or may not have noticed, but I purchased new glasses a couple of weeks ago. I'm somewhat limited in frame choices because of the "heaviness" of my prescription.

I was able, though, to find a frame I liked that was actually smaller than the ones I had. This is good because the smaller the frame, the "lighter" the lenses.

When I put them on for the first time, I immediately noticed that some of the things faraway were a little blurry. However, after I adjusted them a bit, things came into focus. The salesperson said it might take a couple of days to get used to them.

The new frames, apparently, were so much smaller than my old frames (I did not think there was that much difference) that my brain had to be "retrained" in how to use the new glasses. For example, my brain had to learn where the new "line" is on the no-line bifocals.

I knew I needed new glasses—since the previous time my eyes were examined. The change took some getting used to, but now I see much clearer than I had been seeing.

Anytime we are doing something we should not be doing or not doing something we should be doing according to God's Word; we need to make a change. God's will for us is to follow Him.

There is always an adjustment period, but if we just stay the course, we will soon learn how much better our life can be when we make a change and live for God!
