

Carl's Dye-a-logue

In 2 Samuel 14, we read of Joab negotiating a compromised reconciliation between David and Absalom. Absalom, one of David's sons, had murdered Amnon, another of David's sons, who had defiled Tamar, Absalom's sister.

David was upset by this, of course. However, over time. David was comforted concerning Amnon's death and he longed for his son Absalom to return to Jerusalem from banishment.

There is a lot that goes on in 2 Samuel 14, but when we come to verse 24, Absalom is back in Jerusalem, but David seems to have a change of heart and tells Joab that Absalom is to "... dwell apart in his own house; he is not to come into my presence."

David could not bring himself to full forgiveness. He wanted to bring Absalom back, but when he returned, David said he could live in his own house, but not come to see him.

David waited two whole years before he finally relented and allowed a complete reconciliation (verse 33). Two years wasted. Two years of continuing to hold a grudge.

Absalom will eventually conspire against David. Perhaps David's two-year grudge was part of the reason. Four years later, David has to flee Jerusalem because of Absalom.

As Jesus is teaching His followers to pray, He tells them pray, ". . . forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors" (Matthew 6:12).

When one asks forgiveness, our forgiveness cannot be conditional. When we grant forgiveness (and, by the way, if you refuse to forgive others, I really hope you never sin), we cannot continue to hold or nurse a grudge.

When a person asks to be forgiven, we forgive: no strings attached. We do not keep bringing it up to them. We do not keep talking about it with others. The matter is settled. It is done. It is over.

By failing to "forget" we place ourselves in a precarious position of having God remember our sins, instead of remembering that He forgave and forgot them!
