the adventures of Piglet and Pooh, watching  
cartoons, going to Disney movies, and wishing on  
stars.

You get to frame rainbows, hearts, and flowers under  
refrigerator magnets and collect spray painted noodle  
wreaths for Christmas, hand prints set in clay for  
Mother's Day, and cards with backward letters for  
Father's Day.

For \$160,140, there is no better value out there! You get to  
be a hero just for retrieving a Frisbee off the garage roof,  
taking the training wheels off a bike, removing a splinter,  
filling a wading pool, coaxing a wad of gum out of bangs, and  
coaching a baseball team that never wins but always gets  
treated to ice cream regardless.

You get a front row seat to history to witness the first step,  
first word, first date, and first time behind the wheel. You get  
to be immortal.

You get another branch added to your family tree, and if  
you are blessed, a long list of limbs in your obituary called  
grandchildren. You get an education in psychology, nursing,  
criminal justice, communications, and human sexuality that no  
college can match.
