

HE KNOWS OUR SORROWS

There are certain images in my mind that will not go away for a long time. Some of those are the recent encounters with the Ukrainian refugees in Madrid, Spain. The memories of seeing the Ukrainian men who have been injured and lost some parts of their bodies. They were regular men with regular jobs and with loving families and suddenly, everything changed! The image in my mind of the Ukrainian children playing "hide and seek" while the mothers are desperately making phone calls to try to see if a relative is still alive or trying to find out if there is anything left of their homes back home. Children are children no matter where they are from, they are innocent; and the Ukrainian children were not different.

There are so many sad stories that will remain in my mind for a long time in relation to the suffering that the Ukrainian people are going thru. I cannot imagine when the time comes to go to bed and their minds betray them and they cannot sleep because of what all they are going thru. How about us? We are not exempt of problems of our own. How many of us end our day knowing we will not rest at night because of worry, concern, grief, and uncertainty? As we see our friends, neighbors, and loved ones deal with challenges such as these, we want to be able to provide answers that will make everything "better." Unfortunately, as badly as we want to fix problems and take away burdens, we generally cannot alleviate the emotional suffering of those we care about with our words alone!

Fortunately, we can turn to God for guidance, care, comfort, and concern. As we deal with challenges personally or assist others, may we consider the following passages:

Philippians 4:13 says I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

I Peter 5:7 says casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Psalms 55:22 says Cast your burden on the Lord, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

James 1:12 says Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

If we will submit and focus on the strength of our Lord during times of difficulty, we can become stronger by knowing: 1. We can face our challenges. 2. God knows our cares & is concerned for us. 3. God sustains those who seek righteousness. 4. Our faith will allow us to receive God's promises.

So many of our number are experiencing pain & loss. As we go throughout days with seemingly unbearable challenges, may we cling to our Creator to help us get through sleepless nights by moving closer to Him.
