Theological Conversations #9 – Essential, Important, Personal

What is <u>theology</u>? An <u>organized</u> belief about <u>God</u>.

• Not every disciple is a good <u>theologian</u>...why?

1 Timothy 4:16, "Keep a close watch on how you live and on you teaching..."

What we <u>believe</u> matters...but not every <u>belief</u> matters in the same way.

What is the difference between things that are <u>essential</u>, important, and <u>personal</u>?

Answer: <u>Essential</u> elements are necessary for <u>salvation</u>.
 <u>Important</u> elements do not save us but are important to help us follow Jesus <u>faithfully</u>. <u>Personal</u> elements are matters of <u>opinion</u> that don't come with clear direction from God.

Essential Elements – Written in <u>Blood</u>

- The gospel is the core essential of the Bible. Ephesians 2:8 -9
- <u>Grace</u> the gospel
- Obedient faith the response to the gospel

Important Elements – Written in ink.

 Other Biblical truths are important because they come from <u>God</u>, we seek to understand and live our lives in <u>light</u> of all of God's truth.

Personal Elements – Written in pencil.

- Romans 14:1, "As for the one who is weak in the flesh, welcome him, but do not quarrel over <u>opinions</u>."
- On this 3rd level, we have <u>freedom</u> because God does not tell us exactly what we are to do, or his <u>direction</u> is not clear.

Personal elements are never a green light to be <u>unwise</u>.

Wrapping Up...

- It is possible to know what is <u>essential</u>, understand what is essential, and <u>believe</u> what is essential and still completely miss <u>Jesus</u>.
- True faith for the follower of Jesus is lived out in real life.
- Knowing an <u>answer</u> to a question is important, but not as important as allowing the answer to <u>transform</u> us into who we are supposed to be.
