Effective **October 15, 2025**, Beltline Church of Christ will transition from **Pushpay** to **Realm Connect** for electronic giving and church communication. If you need to set up an account to use **Realm Connect**, send an email to: office@beltlinechurchofchrist.org requesting an invite. We will send an email to you with instructions on how to access the app and your account.

Realm Connect offers a simpler, more cost-effective solution that combines giving, church directory access, and communication in one app. It has already been in use by many members and staff and will now be extended to the entire congregation.

- After that, you should print any reports you need and then **delete your Pushpay account**. Please note once Pushpay is discontinued, contribution reports will no longer be accessible.

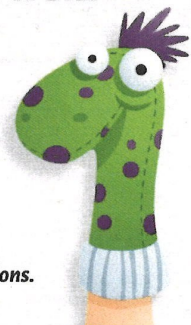

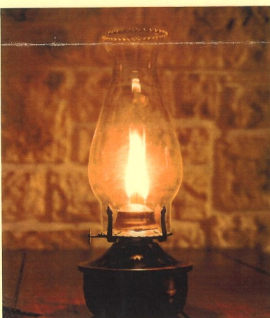
