

Letter from Gregg Pritchard . . .

Connie and I found our family at the Beltline Church of Christ when we moved to Alabama in 1985. The love was overwhelming for two Oklahoma kids with nearest immediate family about 700 miles away. In 2002, the congregation asked me to become an elder and I was deeply humbled at this great appointment. For 23 years I did my best to follow the Word and make decisions for this family of believers such as our Lord would make, indeed this is His church and bride.

My life has had little sickness or time in hospitals until 2019. Diagnosed with renal failure I have been on dialysis for 6 years now. I felt the many hours of sitting in a chair was manageable against the duties of an elder. In November 2024, I was dramatically humbled with a by-pass surgery which seemly kept me in the hospital on and off for 10 months. God blessed me in so many ways during this time thanks to the fervent prayers from the church. I am still in recovery for wounds which keep me from getting away from home as often as I would like. My fellow elders have taken on double duties to cover for my absence. Due to my recovery taking so long, I feel it is in the best interest of this church body and my service to God to step aside from the role of elder. I am confident there are more capable men ready to serve the role of elder. My love for this church and the eldership is not diminished; I will serve in every way that I can as my health hopefully improves.

I want to express thanks to my family; Connie, Jonathan & Amber, Jessica, and David & Laura as influencers in my spiritual growth. I have listened to their perspectives on life to help me get a broader understanding of situations. Thank you to the elders, both current and past, for being friends who ministered to my spiritual life, my prayer life, and wonderfully served as shepherds to my soul. We have been through both good and difficult times. I want to thank you, the Beltline church, for making these 23 years a season of joy to me according to Hebrews 13:17 "Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you." I look forward to the coming years to serve in subjection to this eldership. The Beltline church is growing and healthy. May God continue to richly bless each of us individually and as this family of believers.
