⁹ Pray like this:

*Once you have acknowledged God as the perfect Creator of every good thing, it naturally follows that we would confess our shortcomings to Him. We know how wonderful He truly is, and how far we have fallen. Yet, He loves us! He calls us to repent, so confess specific sins, and ask Him for forgiveness that is available through Jesus Christ, **Psalms 51:10-13 & 1 John 1:9**.*

*This is a time to thank Him for everything good in our lives, **James 1:17**. In Christ we possess every spiritual blessing! Thank God for Life, Protection, Provision, Relationships. Thank Him for giving us what we need & not always what we want, **Deuteronomy 10:12-13**.*

*Prayers of requests. Finally, ask God for His help. Pray for others & their needs. Pray for the church and her success in seeking & saving the lost! Pray for healing and blessings! Ask for everything in Jesus name, **John 16:23**.
