April 19, 2026, AM Worship

Therefore...

- Grace comes first. Identity comes first. Belonging comes first. THEN comes the call to walk worthy.

Ephesians 4:1-3 – Paul is describing the relational atmosphere that MUST exist if the church is going to live out chapters 4-6 together.

1. Humility

- In the kingdom of Christ, humility is foundational.
- Humility says...I am saved by grace, NOT superiority. I belong to the body by mercy, NOT merit. I do not stand above my brother or sister.

Practical Humility...

- Humility listens. Defers. Repents quickly. Assumes the best instead of the worst.

2. Gentleness – is strength under control.

- It means I do not use my strength to crush you. I do not weaponize truth. I do not win arguments and lose people.
- The church God has always wanted is NOT harsh, reactive, or cutting. It is firm in truth but tender in Spirit.

3. Patience - Literally, it means long-tempered.

- The church God has always wanted is NOT filled with easily offended people. It is filled with long-suffering saints.

4. Bearing with one another in love.

- This means I stay when it would be easier to leave. I love when it would be easier to withdraw. I absorb irritation for the sake of the relationship.
- The words IN LOVE show this is NOT mere tolerance. It is NOT cold endurance. It is a covenant conviction.
- **The church God has always wanted is NOT a collection of consumers. It is a family that chooses to remain.**

5. Eagerly maintaining unity in the bond of peace.

- Unity is a gift before it is a goal. Unity does NOT accidentally drift into existence.

The Question is NOT just *do I believe chapters 1-3?* The question is *does my life make chapters 1-3 visible?*

The church God has always wanted is NOT just doctrinally sound. It is relationally beautiful!
