Why Should we Fight so Hard for Unity? Ephesians 4:1-6

Seven ONES...THREE Movements...

Movement #1 – Our Unity is grounded in the Spirit's Work.

- **ONE Body** – we are NOT many competing spiritual groups, we are one body sharing one life.
- **ONE Spirit** – Every Christian is indwelt by the same Spirit, sealed by the same Spirit, and empowered by the same Spirit.
 - ◊ Just like a physical body cannot survive without breath, the church cannot live without the Spirit.
- **ONE Hope** – The Spirit not only gives life now, but he also gives hope for the future.

Movement #2 – Our Unity is Centered in the Lord We Follow.

- **ONE Lord** – Jesus is LORD. Not Caesar. Not culture. Not self. Christians across the world unite under ONE King.
- **ONE Faith** – The church does NOT invent new messages. The church God has always wanted is NOT united by opinions, but by truth
- **ONE Baptism** – In baptism, we are connecting with Jesus in a powerful way. We die in Christ, we are buried in Christ, and we rise with Christ.

Movement #3 – Our Unity Flows from the Father who Reigns Over All.

- **Over All** – The church is NOT ultimately governed by personalities, traditions, or movements...it belongs to God.
- **THROUGH All** – This describes God's active presence working through his people.
- **IN All** – God is present among his people. The God of heaven has chosen to dwell in his church.

The church God has always wanted is not just a group of people who gather in the same room. It is people who share the same life.

Division contradicts the very structure of our salvation.

These are NOT just Nice Christian Virtues...

- Without humility, pride divides us.
- Without gentleness, strength wounds others.
- Without patience, we give up on people too quickly.
- Without love, differences become battlelines.

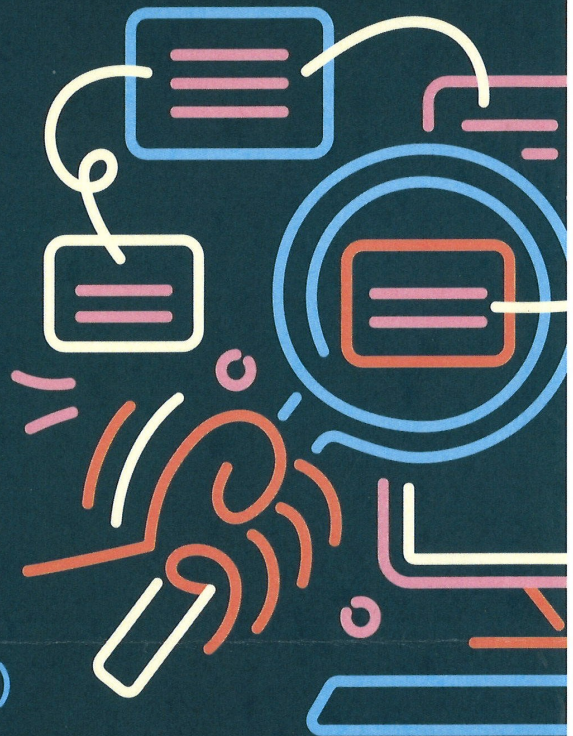
