## The Discipleship Pathway – August 2, 2026

**Luke 19:10**, “*The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.*”

- Acts 5:42; Acts 8:4 - Every disciple understood: **someone told me; now I must tell someone else.**
- The church is never more like Jesus than when it is intentionally moving toward people who are still far from him.

### Matthew 4:18-22

1. A Disciple follows Jesus – *Follow Me*
2. A Disciple is being changed by Jesus – *I Will Make You*
3. A Disciple joins in the mission of Jesus – *Fishers of Men*

### 1. A Disciple **FOLLOWS** Jesus

- **CONNECT – Everyone starts right here!**
- John 1:35-39; John 1:46; John 4:29
- **Discipleship doesn’t begin with perfection. It begins with proximity.**

### Follow Me...

- If you are going to move from this spot on the pathway, you have to make a decision...you must follow Jesus.
- Jesus didn’t say, Believe some facts about me. He said, Follow Me.”
- Following Jesus means recognizing and accepting who Jesus is as Lord, leader, and master of our lives.
- **John 12:26**, “*Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, there my servant also will be.*”

### John 14:23-24

- A willingness to follow Jesus, to connect with Jesus, is evident in our love for him; and though our obedience is not perfect, it should be growing.
- When someone decides to follow Jesus, they must first know who he is, even if they do not fully grasp all that will be required of them as a disciple.
- Transformation comes later; you don’t need a full understanding of everything to take the first step of obedience and connection to Jesus.

**You don’t clean yourself up to come to Jesus. You come to Jesus, and he begins to clean you up.**

**Luke 9:23**, “*Take up your cross daily, and follow me.*”

This is not just a moment, a prayer, or a one-time decision; this is a lifestyle.
