



Corporation/Group	Number of Volunteers	Description of Volunteer Event
Birthday Buddies Ongoing	5-20	Sponsor a birthday party at one of the nine Clubs for all of the children's whose birthday fall in that month. Provide healthy snacks and play party games with Club members.
Clean-up/Maintenance projects Ongoing	20+	Examples include organizing storage closets, painting walls, weeding gardens, prepping softball fields, clearing trails, and building benches.
Summer Scavenger Hunt Summer-anytime	5-30	Help to organize a scavenger hunt with riddles and problems children have to solve in order to find items. The goal is for children to get active, have fun, and using critical thinking skills.
Read & Feed Day Summer-anytime	5-20	Work one on one with young Club members on literacy skills. Serve healthy snacks.
Kickball with the Kids anytime	5-20	Organize a kickball, soccer, basketball, etc. tournament or game with Club members followed by a cookout or healthy snack.
Day for Kids September	5-20	Assist in leading and supervising field activities and games for 150+ Club members. Help serve snacks and refreshments.
Sport Equipment/ Art Supply Drives Ongoing	20+	Organize a sports equipment or art supply drive to benefit Boys & Girls Clubs. List provided. Deliver supplies to Club and help organize them.
Back to School Supply Drive July-August	20+	Organize a back to school supply drive to benefit Boys & Girls Clubs. List provided. Deliver supplies to Club and help organize them.
Christmas Toy Drive/ Holiday Helpers December	5-20	Organize a toy drive to benefit Boys & Girls Clubs. List provided. Help wrap presents for the annual Christmas Party. Adopt ten (or more!) Club members to purchase complete holiday wish lists for.
Be an Annual Campaign team December - August	5-20	Join the Annual Campaign to help raise operating funds for Boys & Girls Clubs. Goal=\$5,000 per team.
Job Shadowing Ongoing	5-20	Organize a Job Shadowing program at your place of employment. Job Shadowing allows Club members the opportunity to spend a day with professionals working in the students' area of career interest. The student has the opportunity to experience what the job is like and can ask questions too!
