- In his first season, Frank Martin guided Kansas State to a 21-12 overall record, including a third-place conference finish at 10-6. He became just the second rookie coach in school history to lead his team to the NCAA Tournament and the first since Lon Kruger (1986-87).
- The Wildcats advanced to the NCAA's last season for the first time since 1995-96. The program got its first NCAA victory since 1988 with an 80-67 victory over USC in the first round.
- In his two-year affiliation with the program, Martin has helped KSU post consecutive 20-win seasons for the first time in nearly 20 years. The 20 league wins are the most in a two-year span in 21 seasons.
- K-State's third-place conference finish a year ago was the best since the inception of the Big 12 and the highest since the 1988-89 team finished third in the Big Eight.
- The lone returning starter for the Wildcats is sophomore Jacob Pullen. As a freshman he had 14 starts and 33 games played, averaging 9.7 points and leading the team with 106 assists.
- Kansas State lost All-American and Big 12 Player of the Year Michael Beasley to the professional ranks. He was chosen second by the Miami Heat, tying the Big 12 record for the highest selection by any player in league history.

### Bushi Awaji, F, 6-3, 185, Los Angeles, Calif./Loyola/Citrus

- Two-year letterman at Citrus College where he helped the team to its first CCCAA State Championship and Western South Conference title.
- Selected first-team All-State and Co-Most Valuable Player of the WSC after tallying 1,021 points shooting.
- Averaged 16.5 points, 4.9 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.3 steals last season, ranking in the top five in every team category including first in scoring.

### Denis Clemente, G, 6-1, 175, Bayamon, Puerto Rico/Calusa Prep [Fla.]/Miami [Fla.]

- Saw action in 27 games at Miami (Fla.), averaging 9.8 points on 43.5 percent shooting.
- Scored in double figures 11 times with three 20-point outings in 2006-07, including a career-high 24 points on two occasions.
- Started in the last four games two years ago for the Hurricanes, including all three NIT contests.

### Abdul Herrera, C, 6-10, 265, Miami, Fla./South Miami/Hutchinson [Kan.]

- Finished with 10.3 points and 7.3 rebounds per game at South Carolina Aiken.

### Jamar Samuels, F, 6-7, 215, Washington, D.C./The Patterson School [N.C.]

- Redshirted last season before earning a scholarship for the 2008-09 season.
- Played in nine games with eight starts for The Patterson School, where he averaged a team-leading 18.0 points and 11.0 rebounds.
- Transferred to The Patterson School after playing two seasons at Archbishop Carroll High. He averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and three blocks as a junior, and 12 points, 10 rebounds and four blocks as a sophomore at Carroll.

- Big 12 Newcomer of the Year DeMarre Carroll recorded 22 double-digit scoring performances during the 2007-08 season. He totaled 71 points in his last four outings and led the team in both points (417) and rebounds (213).
- Senior guard Matt Lawrence led the Tigers with 72 field goals from 3-point range last year, one-third of the team total. He has made 162 shots from beyond the arc in his career, eighth on the all-time Mizzou list.
- Missouri had single-digit turnover totals in four of the last six games in 2007-08. During that span, MU posted 24 fewer turnovers than its opponents.
- MU's offense averaged 12.9 miscues on the season, the lowest mark in school history. The Tigers led the conference in turnover margin with a +3.97 mark.
- Senior forward Leo Lyons finished last season with 405 points. Prior to 2007-08, he had combined for 287 points in his first two seasons at Mizzou.
- Lawrence shot 91.3 percent from the free throw line last season, a mark that ranked second in the Big 12 among all players with more than five attempts on the season. He missed just one free throw in Big 12 competition.

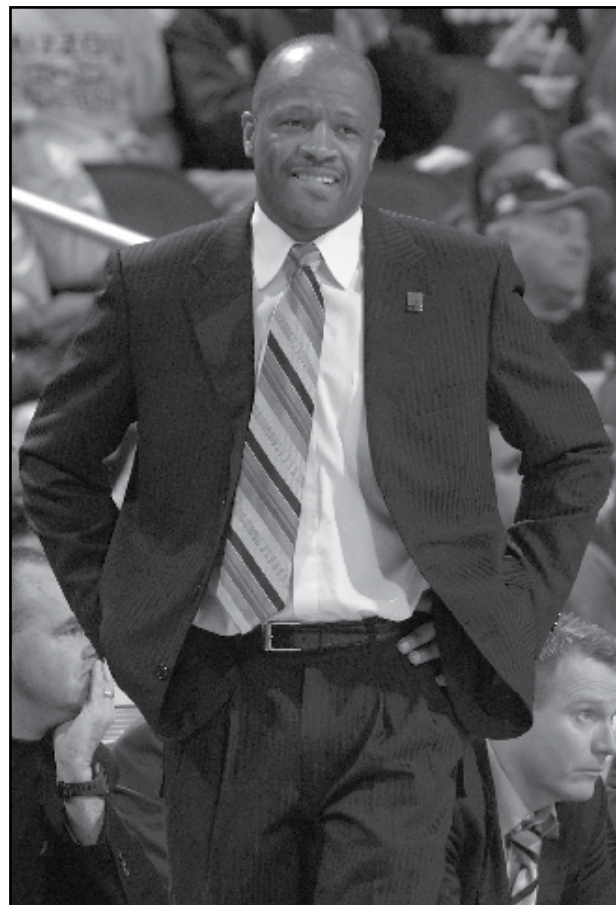
