- Nebraska reached the 20-win mark last season for the 12th time in the program's 112-year history and first since 1998-99. Only six NU squads have won more games than the 2007-08 Huskers.
- Head coach Doc Sadler has won 37 games in his first two seasons at Nebraska. The total matches the highest by a Husker mentor in the first two seasons (Paul Schlisser, 1920-21).
- The Huskers bring back 11 letterwinners after losing only one starter. The returners comprised 63 percent of the team's scoring and rebounding last season and more than 78 percent of the steals.
- Senior guard Steve Harley averaged 12.1 points over the final 12 games of the 2007-08 campaign, connecting at 50.5 percent from the floor.
- NU returnees shot 85.3 percent (162-of-190) of the team's field goals from 3-point range, led by junior Ryan Anderson (50). He needs five 3-pointers to move into the Huskers' career top 10.
- NU reached the second round of the 2008 NIT. The program has not had back-to-back postseason appearances since 1997-98 (NCAA) and 1998-99 (NIT).

## 2008 - 09 NEWCOMERS

### Alex Chapman, F, 6-9, 240, Canby, Ore./Canby/Sheridan [Wyo.]

- Redshirted last season while a member of the Nebraska squad.
- Led the team in 3-pointers (20) and field-goal percentage (46.4), while adding a team-high 6.6 rebounds as a freshman at Sheridan College in 2006-07.
- Played AAU basketball with the Portland Panthers, and helped the team to the Elite Eight of the Reebok Big Time in Las Vegas.

### Alonzo Edwards, F, 6-7, 225, Houston, Texas/Klein Forest

- Redshirted during the Huskers' 2007-08 campaign.
- Averaged 17 points as a high school senior and was ranked as high as No. 13 in the state by texashoops.com.
- Ranked among the top 125 players nationally by ESPN.com, including No. 18 at small forward.

### Eshaunte Jones, G, 6-4, 180, Fort Wayne, Ind./Hargrave M.A. [Va.]

- Averaged 16 points and five rebounds to help Hargrave Military to a 12-0 start before suffering a season-ending injury. The team went undefeated with a 29-0 record while winning the National Prep Invitational title.
- Three-time, first-team all-conference selection, and was the school's all-time scoring leader with 1,759 points. Named the area player of the year and a McDonald's All-America nominee as a senior.

### Toney McCray, G, 6-6, 205, Missouri City, Texas/Fort Bend Elkins

- Took a redshirt year while on NU's team last season.
- Ranked among the top 10 players in Houston by two recruiting services.
- Averaged 16 points and six rebounds, helping his team to a district title as a senior in 2006-07.

### Christopher Niemann, C, 6-11, 230, Kühlungsborn, Germany/Erdgas Ehingen/Urspringchule

- The second foreign player to join the Huskers under Doc Sadler, and the fourth in the past four years to sign with Nebraska.
- Shot 50 percent from the field and averaged 5.0 points and 4.8 rebounds while helping team to its second straight title in German NBBL Under-19 league.

### Brandon Richardson, G, 6-0, 160, Los Angeles, Calif./Hawthorne

- Part of the Nebraska program last year, but redshirted during the season.
- Named a first-team all-state selection following each of his last two high school campaigns.
- Recorded 20.4 points and 7.0 rebounds per game his senior year.

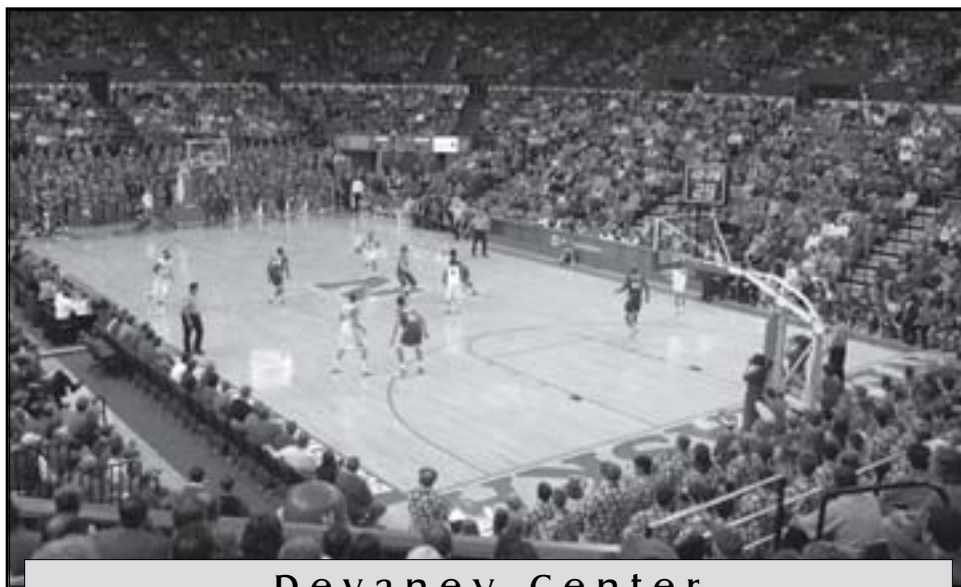

- Forward Blake Griffin was the first freshman in OU history to earn All-Big 12 First, Second or Third team honors. He led the squad in scoring (14.7 ppg), rebounding (9.1 rpg) and field goal percentage (.568).
- Oklahoma made its 25th NCAA appearance last season. The Sooners have made the NCAA's in 12 of the last 14 years and have competed in postseason play in 25 of the past 26 campaigns.
- OU has won at least 20 games in a season 10 times in the last 11 years. The Sooners have also won nine or more Big 12 contests in 10 of 12 seasons since the conference began in 1996-97.
- Senior guard Austin Johnson had 18 assists with just eight turnovers in his last five contests a season ago. He had multiple assists in 20 outings during the 2007-08 campaign.
- Sophomore Cade Davis was the only player in the Big 12 last year (with more than four attempts) to finish perfect from the free throw line. He was 23-of-23 from the charity stripe on the season.
- OU's top 10 national recruiting class consists of two high school guards, three junior college transfers and a transfer from UCLA who is eligible for action this season.

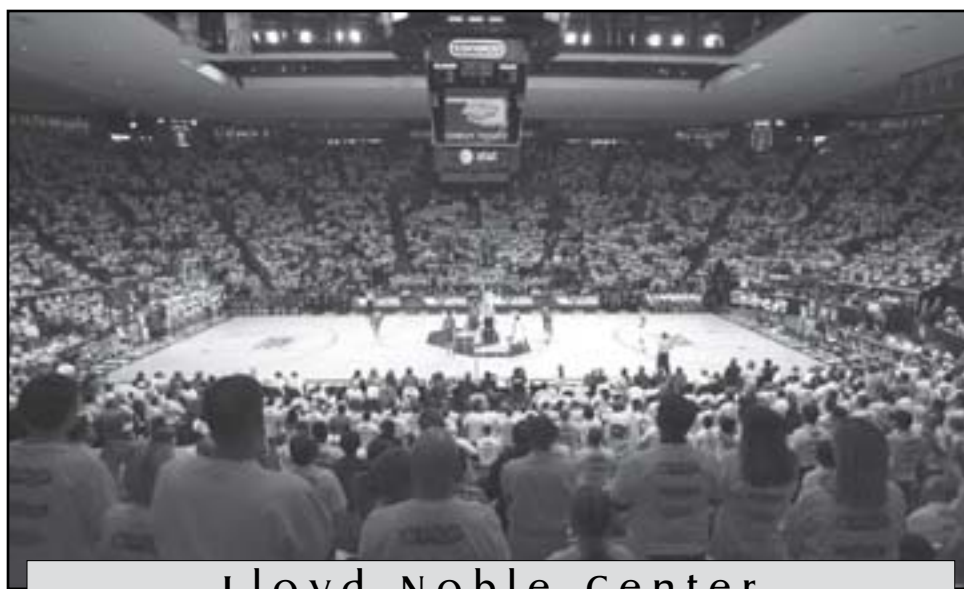
