- Oklahoma State returns its top four and six of its top seven scorers from last season. Overall, 81.3 percent of the Cowboys point production will take the floor again this year.
- Senior guard Byron Eaton is the only returning player in the Big 12 who recorded 100 or more assists and 60 or more steals a year ago. He finished with 116 assists and 69 thefts.
- Eaton has dished out 31 assists in Big 12 Championship play over the past three years. The total is first among active players and ranks eighth on the all-time conference career list.
- Sophomore guard James Anderson led Oklahoma State in scoring last year with 13.3 points per game. His total of 438 points was the second-highest freshman mark in school history.
- OSU qualified for postseason play for the 19th time in the last 20 seasons in 2007-08. Prior to the current string, the Cowboys had a total of 13 all-time postseason appearances.
- Oklahoma State shot 71.5 percent from the free throw line last year, third in the Big 12. The Cowboys have connected at 71 percent or better from the charity stripe each of the last four seasons. OSU has led the Big 12 in shooting from the line four times - more than any other school in league history.

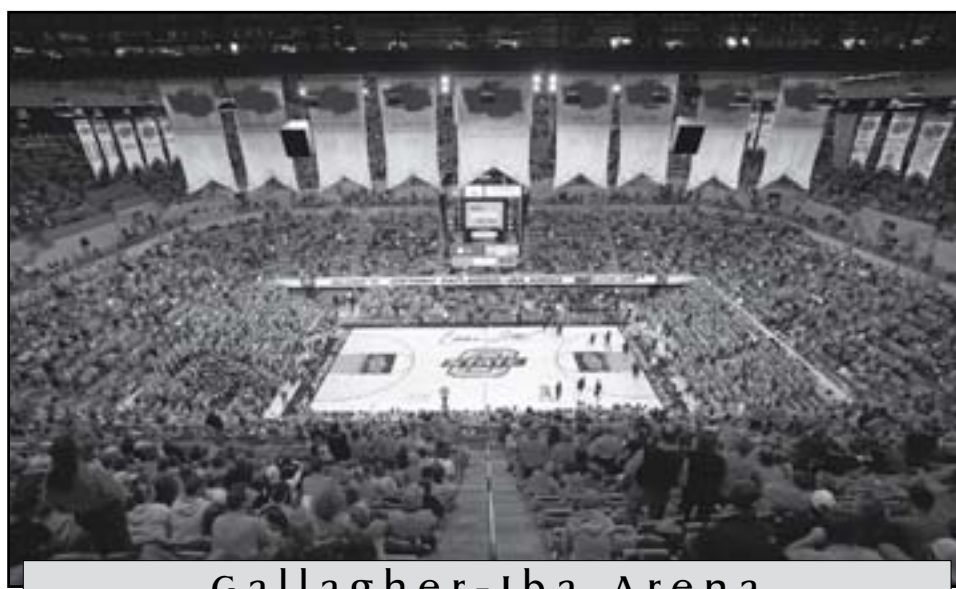

- Texas returns 10 letterwinners, including four starters, from last season's Elite Eight team. The Longhorns bring back 73.3 percent of the scoring, 89.7 percent of rebounds and 79.3 percent of their minutes played from a year ago.
- UT is one of just three schools to have reached the Sweet 16 in five of the last seven years. The program is one of eight nationally to have advanced to each of the last 10 NCAA Championships.
- The Longhorns played 20 of its 38 games last season against squads that participated in the 2008 NCAA Championships, posting a 15-5 record in those contests.
- With 31 victories, the 2007-08 Longhorns set a school record. UT has won at least 25 games in five of the past six years.
- UT finished No. 7 in the final Associated Press poll. It marks the fifth time in the last six seasons that the Longhorns have been ranked in the top 12 of the final poll. During the Rick Barnes era, the team has spent 128 weeks in the AP Top 25, including 52 in the top 10.
- Forward Damion James set the Texas single-season rebounding record with 393 boards. The total is the second-most in Big 12 history and is the most ever by a league sophomore.

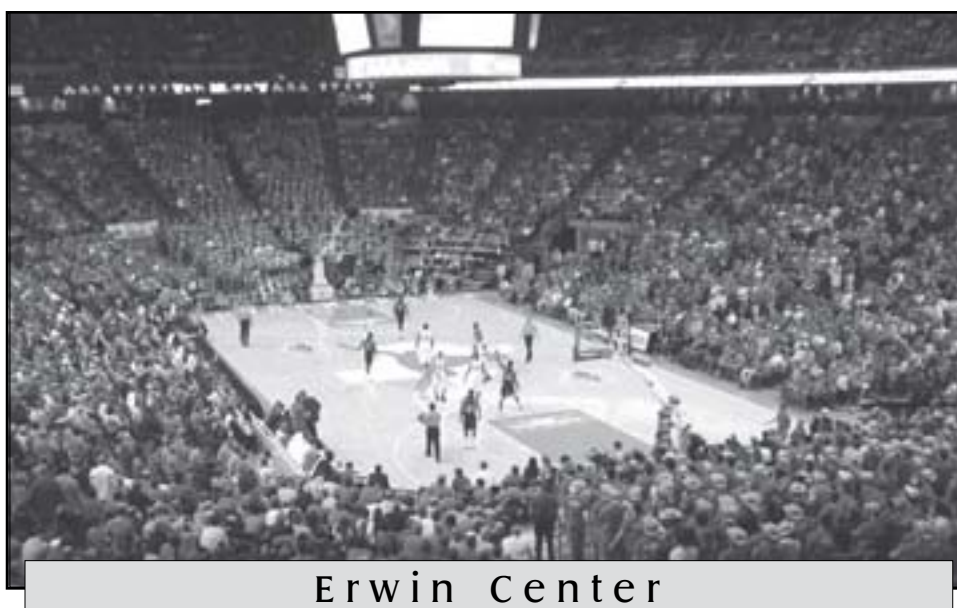
