- The 25 wins under Mark Turgeon last season were the most by a first-year coach in Big 12 history. The Aggies 67 home wins in the last four years ranks as the second-most in the country.
- Texas A&M has earned three straight NCAA bids for the first time in school history. They are one of nine programs nationally to win at least one NCAA game each of the last three seasons.
- A&M is one of two league schools (KU) to win at least 21 games each of the past four seasons. The Aggies have at least eight conference wins per year in that time after never having won more than six Big 12 contests in any one season.
- The Aggies have held 13 of their last 16 opponents to 69 points or less. In 2007-08, just eight foes crossed the 70-point plateau.
- Junior Bryan Davis had double-digit points in four of the last five contests a season ago, after having nine double-figure scoring outputs prior to that time. He shot 62.5 percent or better in each of the last five games.
- A&M set school records for single-game attendance and average home attendance last season, ranking in the top half of the Big 12 for the first time.

- Senior guard Alan Voskuil totaled 405 points last year, finishing second on the squad with 13.1 points per game. Prior to the '07-08 campaign, he had scored a total of 244 career points in two seasons.
- Voskuil and sophomore guard John Roberson combined to make 121 of Tech's 160 shots from 3-point range last season. Overall, the Red Raiders return 89.7 percent of their makes from beyond the arc.
- Roberson scored in double figures in three of his last four games last year, while reaching the plateau 18 times overall. He had 20 points or more seven times and finished third on the team in scoring with 380 points.
- Pat Knight will begin his first full season at the helm of the Tech men's basketball program. He coached the last 11 games of 2007-08 after taking over for his father, Bob, the all-time winningest coach in NCAA history.
- Tech has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line each of the past five seasons. The Red Raiders return nine letterwinners from a year ago, including four players who connected at .720 or better from the stripe.
- Texas Tech scored 75.1 points per game at home in 2007-08, en route to a 13-3 home mark. The Red Raiders averaged just 62.0 points at road venues.
