

# **Kansas Jayhawks**

Kansas returns 88 percent of its scoring and 80 percent of its rebounding in 2008-09.

Four starters and eight other letterwinners return to the mix, including last season's leading scorer, junior Danielle McCray.

Two newcomers will also join the team.

McCray totaled 14.9 ppg and also topped the squad with 7.1 rpg.

Junior Sade Morris was the only player to start all 31 games last season while placing second on the squad in scoring with 9.8 ppg.

The Jayhawks have competed in the WNIT two of the last three seasons, including a third round showing in 2007-08.

KU's 17 victories last season were an improvement of six wins from the previous season.




Kansas State returns five players with starting experience including three (Lehning, Gipson, Sweat) who started 31 of 32 games.

Last season the Wildcats won their second Big 12 regular season title after finishing last in the league the previous year. KSU is the only program in Big 12 men's or women's basketball history to go from last to first in consecutive seasons.

K-State advanced to the NCAA Tournament second round in 2008, its 10th all-time NCAA appearance and fifth since 2002.

The Wildcats have compiled a 5-5 record in NCAA Championship play since the inception of the Big 12 in 1997.

KSU lost top scorer Kimberly Dietz (14.9 ppg), but returns its next four leaders highlighted by Marlies Gipson (11.7), Shalee Lehning (11.3) and Ashley Sweat (11.2) all averaging over 11 points an outing.



## **Missouri Tigers**

Missouri returns 98.6 percent of its scoring production from last season with six players who started at least 15 games.


Senior Alyssa Hollins led the Tigers in scoring last season with 16.6 ppg. With 933 career points, she needs 67 points to become Mizzou's 26th player to reach 1,000 career points.

Two other double-digit scorers also return in Jessra Johnson (13.5 ppg) and Shakara Jones (10.5 ppg). Johnson also led the squad in rebounding with 7.7 an outing.

The Tigers welcome four freshmen newcomers along with a redshirt freshman and two new assistant coaches.

Hollins holds MU's career record for three-point field goals made with 166, and set the single season record last year with 90 treys.

The Tigers became the first 12th seed to advance past the first round with their win over Oklahoma in the 2008 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship.
