Texas returns four starters and five additional letterwinners to its 2008-09 squad while welcoming three freshmen newcomers.

The Longhorns' top five scorers from last season are back, led by junior Brittainy Raven who averaged 15.2 ppg. Ashley Lindsey (11.0) and Carla Cortijo (10.1) were also double-figure scorers a year ago.

Texas made its 22nd appearance in the NCAA Championship in 2008, which is tied for third-most all-time and leads Big 12 schools. UT has registered a 32-21 (.603) mark in NCAA tournament games.

The Longhorns ended the 07-08 season with a 22-13 mark, going 6-2 down the stretch. The 22 wins were the most for the squad since going 22-9 in 2004-05.

Texas continues its long-standing tradition against 2008 National Champion Tennessee with this year's matchup set for December 14 in Austin.


Texas A&M returns three starters and five other letterwinners from last year's squad that advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight for the first time in program history.

The Aggies' top two scorers from last season return in seniors Takia Starks (16.3 ppg) and Danielle Gant (14.7 ppg). Gant was the team's top rebounder with 7.1 a game.

A&M played 37 games in 2007-08, the second-most in school history, and finished with a 29-8 record to mark the most victories in 34 seasons of Aggie Basketball.

TAMU has recorded three consecutive 10-wins seasons in Big 12 play and finished in the top three of the league standings in that same span.

The Aggies registered a school-record 12-game win streak from Feb. 17-March 30, 2008 and won 16 of their final 18 contests.







Texas Tech Lady Raiders

Texas Tech returns eight letterwinners to its 2008-09 squad, including six who started 11 or more games last season.


Senior Dominic Seals led the Lady Raiders in scoring (13.9), rebounding (8.3) and blocked shots (49) last season. She registered nine double-doubles, which was second in the Big 12 en route to Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honors.

Tech will have depth in the backcourt as it brings back a total of six guards and has added two newcomers at the position. Senior Maria Moore led the team with 120 assists last season while chipping in 7.2 points a game.

Texas Tech has finished in the top seven nationally in home attendance every year since the inception of the Big 12.

The Lady Raiders' 128 wins in Big 12 play are a leaguebest. The program has compiled a conference-leading 77-19 record in Big 12 home games.

Texas Tech has made 18 NCAA Tournament appearances and compiled a record of 30-17 (.638). The 30 NCAA wins rank second among Big 12 teams.
