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First Round Matches Complete At Big 12 Tennis Championships

- Kansas, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, Texas Tech Advance To Quarterfinals -

College Station, Texas - The quarterfinals are set for the Big 12 Tennis Championships at the George P. Mitchell Tennis Center as half of the higher seeds advanced on the women's side of the bracket. The quarterfinal play will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, with a total of eight men's and women's matches being contested in College Station.

In the first matches of the day, Kansas and Texas Tech both advanced with 4-0 and 4-1 victories, respectively. In the match between No. 5-seeded Kansas and No. 12 Iowa State, KU won the doubles point with victories at No. 2 and No. 3. It followed with wins at the No. 3-5 singles positions to claim the victory. All three singles matches were straight set tallies, while the Jayhawks only gave up a total of four points. Ninth-seeded Texas Tech claimed the championship's first upset by defeating No. 8 Oklahoma. Tech captured the doubles point with wins at positions No. 1 and No. 3. In singles action, the Red Raiders were victorious at the No. 2, No. 5 and No. 6. All three of those matches were also in straight sets.

In afternoon first-round matches, Kansas State and Oklahoma State moved on. The sixth-seeded Cowgirls came back in singles claiming matches at No. 1-4. after losing the doubles point to the Tigers en route to a 4-1 victory. No. 11 Missouri's win in doubles came at the No. 1 and No. 3 positions. In a match that went back and forth, Kansas State outlasted Nebraska 4-3. The Wildcats clinched the victory with a 10-8 win in the tiebreak set. KSU took the doubles point before claiming singles victories at No. 1, No. 2 and No. 4.
