Texas Head Coach Connie Clark

On the game:

"It was evident that we have not played in about a week. I think we were little foggy mentally because we had some fundamental mistakes that we can't make at this time. It was good that we had some luck on our side today because we have been on the other side of that many times this year but we do have to be sharper if we want to win this tournament."

On tying run to send the game to extra innings:

"I think the nice thing was she did a nice job of not giving up on that and some times that is not easy to do and she came from second and round third hard and headed home and that turned to be the difference. You talk about those little things and to not give up on a play and those guys did a good job and it turned out to be the difference. It gave us a little extra push and we need a push and the coaches were working hard to get them fired up and get them in the right direction."

Oklahoma State Head Coach Rich Wieligman:

On the game:

"I liked how we kept fighting in this game. We came back and hit a home run to retake the lead. Where the game got tied [in the seventh] was tough. I think that play could have happened a hundred times and that would be an out a hundred times. It's tough that one play can change the game like it did."

On the error in the seventh inning:

"That was her first error all Big 12 and she is a great player and a great kid. It's just a tough circumstance. Like I told our kids, sometimes life is not fair. But we'll bounce back from this and we'll get better."
