On the performance of Molly Hill:

"She told me after the first game that she got all of her walks out of the way then. She was stronger in the second game, and the hits that they got weren't strong hits. I thought she did a great job of controlling the tempo. The way the defense played behind her was outstanding as well."

On the play of the freshman:

"We don't have freshman anymore, the school year is over. Honestly, we had a little freshman graduation ceremony the other night, and I think its showing. No one is playing like a freshman."

On the Game:

"Well, it was not our best game; it's kind of frustrating when you out hit a team and you lose six-to-one. We didn't execute pitches during the game the way we could have or need to win games and didn't play defense like we need to and that is the difference in the game. I thought that Sarah (Losleben) did a great job throwing when she came in and kept the hitters off balance but we didn't play fundamentally sound with execution of pitches against our defense but I thought we got enough pitches to win the ballgame but we have got to put it all together."

On Nebraska:

"We obviously know about that hot streak. We lost to them last year. A lot of things go their way and that is what creates hot streaks at times. This game is about skill, execution and I don't think I have every seen anybody win a world series without a little luck or any championship."
