On Texas A&M senior pitcher Megan Gibson:

"What this reminded me of is a pitcher getting in the circle and saying you are not going to deny me and she had a lot of success with her history data base that she can go out and do that. It kind of reminded me Peaches back in '04 going through this tournament saying this is my senior year and this is my tournament. It is very understandable why she was player of the year and pitcher of the year and one of the ten best players in the nation. I think she has just as good of shot as anybody given what she has done this year."

On her team:

"I knew that emotionally that we had a lot in the tank but I just didn't know what we would have physically. I think Molly did a good job and it is not like they hit it hard, they just found spots but I didn't think we got on top of the ball as much as I would like to. You have to give them credit."
