Miscellaneous

- This marks the ninth meeting between the two teams at the Big 12 Championship. The nine meetings are tied with Baylor and Missouri for the most matchups between two squads in postseason conference play.
- The teams are 4-4 in Big 12 Championship play and OU holds a 30-29 all-time series edge.
- TAMU won the last Big 12 postseason meeting 11-2 exactly five years ago to the day.

No. 1 Texas A&M - 1

- Overall record: 42-15
- The Aggies are 15-17 all-time at the Big 12 Championship.
- A&M is now 3-1 versus Oklahoma this season
- TAMU is 5-5 on the first day of Big 12 Championship play.
- The loss marks the seventh-straight defeat, the longest such streak of their season.
- A&M is 5-5 in the Big 12 Championship as a No. 1 seed.
- The one run tied for the lowest outing of the year for the Aggies.
- The 12 strikeouts were the most by Texas A&M batters in 2008.

No. 8 Oklahoma - 4

- Overall record: 33-23-1
- Oklahoma is now 20-19 all-time at the Big 12 Championship.
- The Sooners are 5-6 on the first day of Big 12 Championship play.
- Oklahoma is 8-14-1 against Top 25 teams in 2008.
- OU is 18-0 when its opponent scores three runs or less.
- Andrew Doyle threw a career-high 12 strikeouts, the most by an OU pitcher since 03/23/07.
- Doyle threw 9.0 innings, the second complete game and longest outing of the year for OU.
- With two double plays today, the Sooners have recorded eight in the last three games.
