- This marks the ninth time the two squads have met in the Big 12 Championship. The nine meetings are tied for the most match-ups between two squads in postseason conference play.
- Nebraska holds a 6-3 edge over Baylor in Big 12 Championship play but Baylor holds the all-time series advantage at 30-22.
- Nebraska and Baylor are tied 2-2 in head-to-head match-ups on the season.

No. 3 Nebraska - 4

- Overall record: 39-13-1
- The Huskers are 15-17 all-time at the Big 12 Championship.
- NU is now 7-3 on the first day of Big 12 Championship play.
- The only other two times Nebraska has lost its opening game, they have gone on to win the championship.
- With the loss, the Huskers extend their losing streak to four games, the longest of their season.
- This is the first time NU has played in the Big 12 postseason as a No. 3 seed.
- Sophomore Tyler Farst tied his season high in RBI's with three.

No. 6 Baylor - 10

- Overall record: 32-24
- Baylor is now 21-18 all-time at the Big 12 Championship.
- The Bears improved to 5-12 against ranked opponents in 2008.
- BU is 6-2 as the sixth seed in the conference championship.
- Baylor is one of three Big 12 teams to play in every conference championship.
- In Shaver Hanson's first start at clean-up, he knocked in a season-tying high four RBI's.
- By hitting three batter's in today's game and 16 for the season, Shawn Tolleson broke Jason Jennings' single-season school record of 15.
- The four stolen bases recorded in today's game are more than the Bears stole in the entire series against NU earlier in the season.
