Kansas State Head Coach Brad Hill

On the Nebraska pitcher Johnny Dorn:

"I thought we let him off the hook and with 14 guys left on base there is a lot of pressure on him. I know he is a great pitcher and he did some things that we have not seen but he is just a fierce competitor and you have to give him credit. I don't think he was a sharp as what he had been against us in the past but again he is just a fierce competitor and when he needs to make big time pitches, he can do it."
