Missouri head coach Tim Jamieson

On the game:

"We really didn't give ourselves much of a chance offensively to get in the game. If you look at the scoreboard, the numbers are very similar except for the final score. The big three-run home run after a couple of defensive mistakes on our part was really the difference in the game."

On Texas A&M ending their eight-game losing streak:

"You have to tip your hat to A&M. Hopefully we can get them going now for their regional and get that monkey off their back."

On Texas A&M pitcher Barret Loux:

"(Barret Loux) did a heck of a job. I don't think we took but one good swing on him the entire game. He pitched us inside and we didn't make the adjustments. If you can pound the inside part of the plate and throw it for strikes, it's tough to hit. We just couldn't hit what he was throwing."

On Missouri's postseason chances:

"You look around the country, outside of North Carolina and maybe Miami there's no great teams. Whoever gets hot at the right time is going to win a regional, super regional and then get to Omaha; hopefully that's us.
