Miscellaneous

- This marks the first time these two teams have met in the Big 12 Championship.
- With the A&M win, Texas wins Pool 1 and the right to play tomorrow in the Big 12 Championship game.
- A&M swept MU during the regular season, including a 15-0 victory on April 26, the largest margin of victory for the Aggies this season. The 15 runs also tied a season high for TAMU. Starting pitcher Barret Loux was the winning pitcher in that game as well.
- Texas A&M holds a 36-24-1 edge over Missouri all-time.

No. 1 Texas A&M - 6

- Overall record: 43-16
- The Aggies are 16-18 all-time at the Big 12 Championship.
- A&M snapped an eight game losing streak.
- Jose Duran, Big 12 Player of the Year, hit a three-run shot in the fifth inning, his sixth in 2008.
- Luke Anders hit his team-leading 14th homerun in the eighth inning, three have come against the Tigers.
- The Aggies' three homeruns are their most in a Big 12 Championship game.

No. 4 Missouri - 2

- Overall record: 38-19
- Missouri is now 14-18 all-time at the Big 12 Championship.
- Greg Folgia knocked his fifth homer of the year, and his third in the last five games.
- In the ninth inning, Steve Gray hit his fifth homerun in the month of May.
- The Tigers have recorded a 2008 Championship-high eight errors. They did not total eight errors in any three consecutive games this season.
- The two runs tie a Big 12 Championship low for the Tigers since getting shutout by Baylor 11-0 on the first day of play in 2003.
