

On the loss:

"It was a hard-fought contest that didn't come out the way we would have liked it to. But to come back from the deficit we had and take the lead was remarkable. It showed a lot of character. You kind of had a feeling there late in the ball game that whoever was up to bat last was going to have the best opportunity to win, and that's how it ended up. Our road stops here and we will reload and look to next year."

On the season:

"I'm real proud of our student-athletes. We had our backs to the wall for four consecutive games. Unfortunately for us the fourth one didn't turn out the way we wanted. I told our guys it's how you handle yourself after adversity and through adversity is what really defines you and your character. Our young men always do a good job of that."
