

Kansas State Head Coach Brad Hill

*On Kansas State not capitalizing on early opportunities:*

"The first two innings kind of dictated everything. Obviously with the bases loaded and one out we don't score, and then the bases loaded with no outs and we only get one out of it is a huge momentum swing their way. I think we got a little over-anxious in a couple situations. When they scored four in the top of the third, the momentum swing really happened.

*On Texas' three-run top of the sixth:*

"That one hurt. We worked ourselves back in by getting five runs and we really needed a stop right there. Every time we needed a stop we couldn't get it. I felt we had the momentum swing our way and then they come back and got three."

*On if there were any adverse effects from Kansas State's late win Saturday night:*
