- The Bears return five starters who combined for 83.2 percent of their starts (129-for-155) and 90.6 percent of their points. They will bring back nine lettermen that have combined for 246 starts, the highest number at BU in over a decade.
- Junior forward Kevin Rogers doubled his scoring average last season and recorded five double-doubles, the most by a Baylor player in Big 12 games since 2002-03.
- Junior guard Curtis Jerrells was named to the 2007 Big 12 All-Tournament Team after averaging 25.0 points in two games. He scored in double-digits in 14 straight contests to end the season.
- Jerrells is the second Baylor player ever to be named to the Big 12 All-Tournament Team (DeMarcus Minor, 2001).
- Senior guard Aaron Bruce ranks 15th on the career scoring list at BU with 1,060 points. He is ninth on the all-time Big 12 list for 3-point field goals made (117).
- Baylor's 15 wins in 2006-07 were the most under head coach Scott Drew. The Bears also won a game in the Big 12 Championship for the first time since 2001.

- Senior guard Richard Roby led Colorado in scoring in four of the final six games of 2006-07. He averaged 19.8 points during that span.
- Roby is the eighth player in CU history to score more than 1,400 career points (1,456 in 87 games). Only one player in school history - Cliff Meely from 1969-71 - has done it in fewer outings (1,940 in 80).
- Senior Marcus King-Stockton registered 32 blocks a year ago (10th in the conference) doubling the total from his first two seasons.
- Roby is looking to become the third player in school history to lead the team in scoring all four years (Donnie Boyce, 1991-95; Emmett Lewis, 1975-79).
- Sophomore guard Xavier Silas was third on the team in scoring during his freshman campaign with 12.0 points per game. He led the Buffaloes in scoring seven times, including six Big 12 contests, while leading all Colorado freshmen with 301 points.
- Jeff Bzdelik was named the 17th men's basketball coach at Colorado on April 4, 2007. He was 50-16 (.758) in two seasons at Air Force, the best two-year win total in program history.
