- Texas A&M set a record for wins in a season last year. The 27 overall victories broke the school mark set in 1979-80 (26-8).
- Junior Josh Carter set a school record with 86 field goals made from 3-point range in 2006-07. He ranks first on the Big 12 career list in 3-point field goal percentage (.455).
- Carter led the NCAA in 3-point field goal percentage last season, shooting 50 percent from behind the arc. Carter knocked down 86 treys in 172 attempts.
- Senior forward Joseph Jones scored in double-digits in 16 of his last 21 games a year ago. He also finished the season by shooting 60.5 percent (23-of-38) over the last four contests.
- A&M has won 31 Big 12 games in the last three seasons. Prior to that stretch, the Aggies had won a total of 25 league games in the first eight seasons of the Big 12.
- The Aggies led the conference in field goal percentage defense (.375), scoring defense (59.4 ppg), 3-point field goal percentage defense (.294) and rebound defense (30.7 rpg). The field goal defense ranked second nationally.

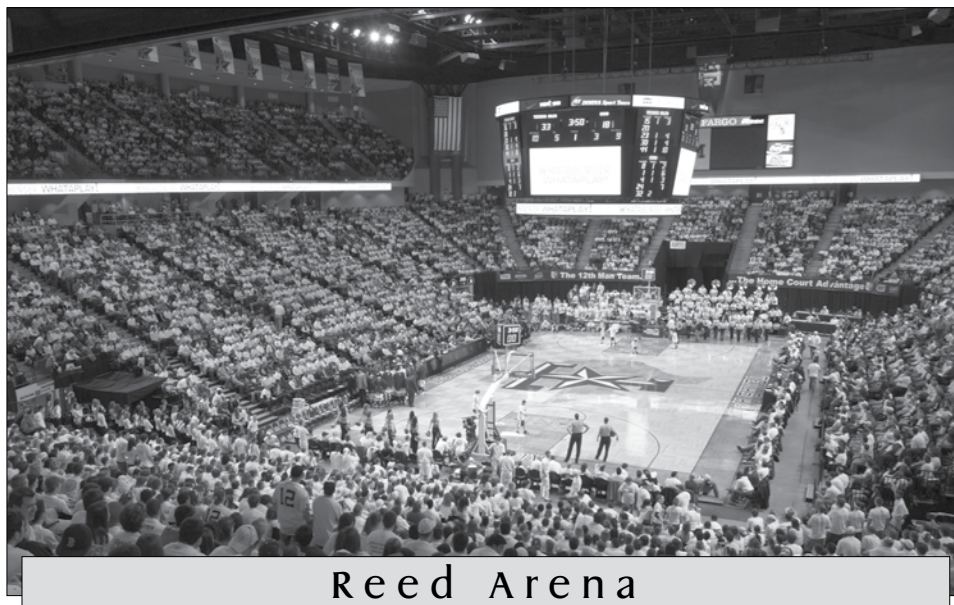

- Senior guard Martin Zeno scored in double-figures in 30 games in 2006-07. He shot 50.0 percent or better 22 times, including nine of the last 12 games.
- Zeno ranks sixth on the Big 12 career list in free throws made with 416. He needs 72 conversions from the stripe to tie the league record (Bernard King, TAMU, 1999-03).
- Tech recorded 20 wins for the fifth time in six years under head coach Bob Knight. Prior to his arrival, the Red Raiders won 20 games three times in the previous 24 seasons.
- Knight garnered win No. 880 to become the all-time winningest Division I coach after the Raiders 70-68 victory over New Mexico. Knight finished the season with 890 wins.
- Senior guard Charlie Burgess scored in double-digits 12 times last season, including two of his final three outings.
- Texas Tech led the Big 12 in free throw percentage overall (.739) and in conference play (.769). It marked the third time the Red Raiders have led the league in the category, the second-most among Big 12 teams (Oklahoma State, 4 times) in league history.
