- Junior center Aleks Maric averaged 8.1 boards last season and is the top returning rebounder in the Big 12. He posted double-figure rebound totals 12 times a year ago, including eight of his last 14 outings. Maric also had 10 double-doubles (a league-high seven in Big 12 games), the most of any conference returnee.
- Maric had 251 rebounds in 2005-06, the second-highest total by a Nebraska sophomore in school history. The mark was 11th overall on the NU single-season chart.
- New head coach Doc Sadler is averaging 24 wins in seven seasons as a head coach, with the same average in two years at Division I.
- Nebraska reached the semifinals of the Big 12 Championship in 2006. It marked just the second time in league history (1998), the Huskers had accomplished the feat. The two tourney victories matched NU's total for the previous nine events.
- Sophomore guard Jamel White connected on 80.2 percent (69-of-86) of his free throws last season, tops among Cornhusker returning regulars.
- Senior guard Charles Richardson ranked fourth in the Big 12 in assist-to-turnover ratio with a 1.92 mark. He has 220 assists in his first three seasons at NU, with 117 turnovers.

- Head coach Jeff Capel, at 31 years old, is the nation's second-youngest head coach. He has won at least 18 games in each of his four seasons at the helm and is averaging nearly 20 wins (19.75) during his career.
- OU has won at least 20 games in each of the last nine seasons. The Sooners have also recorded a first-round Big 12 Championship bye in eight of 10 years.
- Senior guard Michael Neal made at least one 3-point field goal in every game last season. He shot a league-best 49.5 percent from beyond the arc in Big 12 games and hit multiple treys in 13 of 16 league contests.
- Neal connected on 3.9 field goals per conference game from 3-point range in 2005-06, a Big 12 season record. He was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year.
- Oklahoma recorded 11 Big 12 victories in 2005-06, the eighth time in the last nine years the Sooners have posted at least 11 victories in conference play.
- Since Big 12 play began in 1996-97, Oklahoma is tied (Texas) for the second-most victories and second-highest winning percentage in conference games. OU is 111-49 (.694) in 10 seasons.

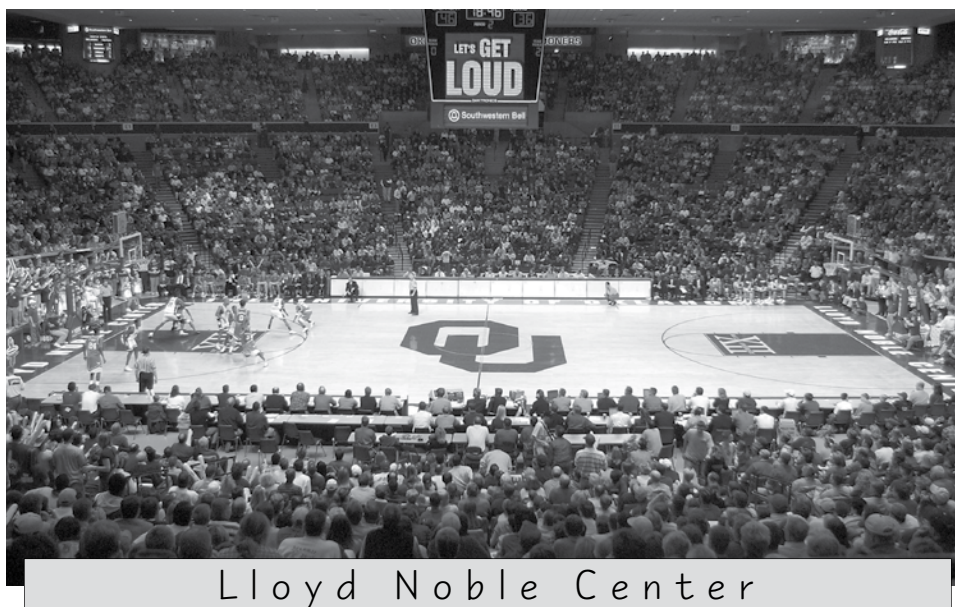
