- The Cornhuskers bring back three of their top four scorers in 2005-06, with 62.7 percent of their scoring returning overall.
- NU's defense has been solid in recent years, as the Huskers have held opponents under 64 points per game each of the past two seasons. A year ago, the squad finished third in the Big 12 in scoring defense (63.9).
- Sophomore guard **Joe McCray** scored 433 points last year, second on the Nebraska all-time list and eighth in Big 12 annals for freshman points. He set a Big 12 and NU freshman record for 3-point field goals (80).
- **McCray** and sophomore center **Aleks Maric** combined to average 23.5 points and 11.3 rebounds last season. McCray scored 20 points or more in 10 games, while Maric set a NU freshman rebound record (169).
- The Huskers have defeated at least one nationally-ranked team each of the last four seasons. Last year, NU topped No. 4 Oklahoma State, 74-67.
- Nebraska led the Big 12 in rebounding margin last season with a +5.2 mark. The Cornhuskers were second overall on the boards, posting 38.3 per contest.

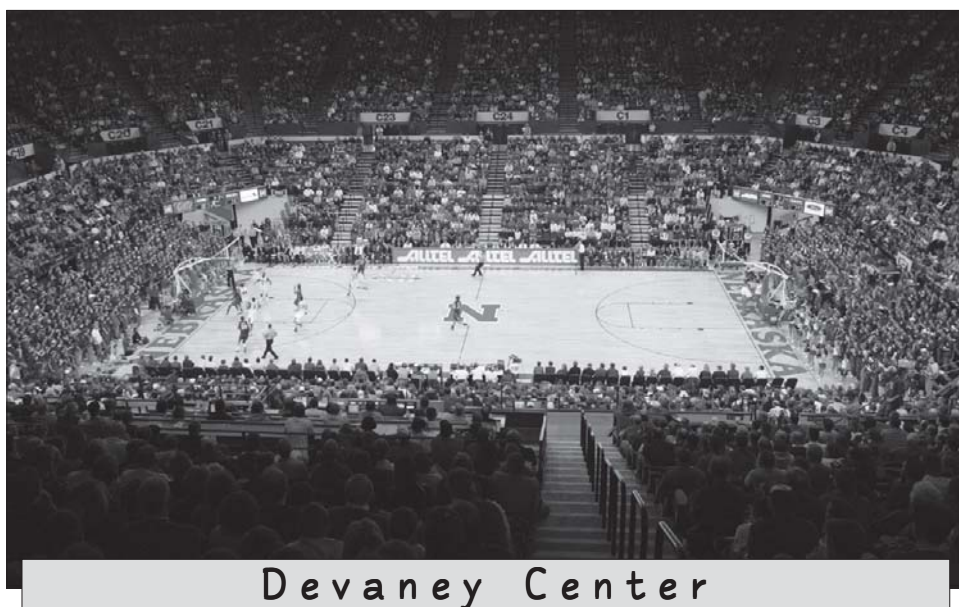

- Senior **Taj Gray** is the lone returning All-Big 12 First Team selection from last season. He was also the Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. The forward led the conference in shooting, hitting at 55.7 percent from the field.
- **Gray** was a member of the 2005 USA Basketball Men's U21 National Team this summer.
- In conference games, **Gray** (59.9 percent) and senior forward **Kevin Bookout** (59.4) finished first and second in the Big 12, respectively, in field goal percentage.
- Senior guard **Terrell Everett** is the top returning assist man in the Big 12 with 166 in 33 games. His 5.0 assist average was the highest by a Sooner in nine seasons (Tyrone Foster, 5.6, 1995-96).
- Sophomore guard **David Godbold** averaged 25.4 minutes over the last 10 games of 2004-05. During that span, he posted 7.4 points and 3.2 rebounds per game.
- Sophomore center **Longar Longar** missed only seven field goal attempts all of last season. He finished 29-of-36 (.806) from the floor.

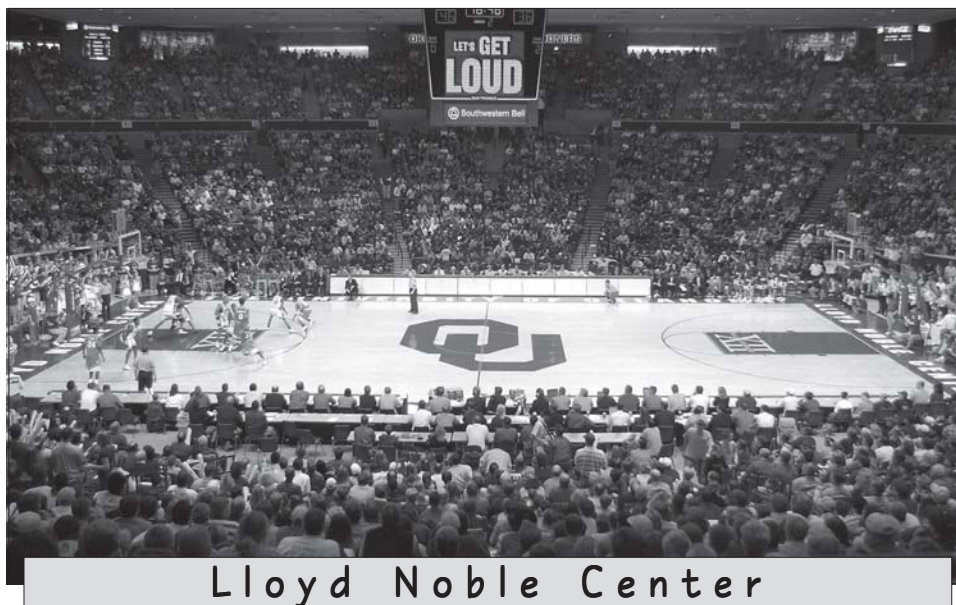
