- Texas A&M recorded the nation's best turnaround in 2004-05, winning 14 more games than the previous season (7-21).
- A&M's 21 overall victories were the third-most in school history. The win total for head coach **Billy Gillispie** marked the most for a first-year Aggie coach.
- Sophomore **Joseph Jones** posted seven double-doubles last season, the most by any Big 12 freshman.
- In Texas A&M's three NIT contests, **Jones** averaged 15.7 points and 8.0 rebounds, including a career-high 25 points versus Clemson.
- The Aggies had eight Big 12 wins last year, the most in school history.
- In 2004-05, the Aggies became just the third team in college basketball history to post a .500 conference mark after going winless in league play the previous season. Miami (Big East: 0-18 to 9-9) and Louisiana Tech (Sun Belt (0-18 to 9-9) were the only other schools to accomplish the feat.

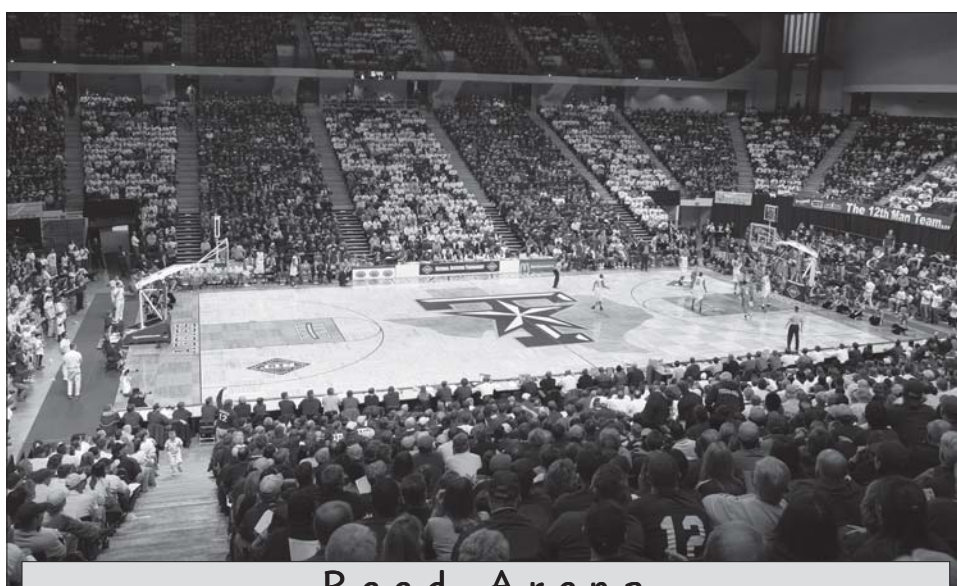

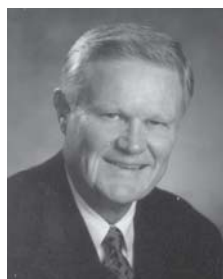

- In each of head coach **Bob Knight's** first four years, Texas Tech has recorded at least 22 victories. Knight-coached teams have won 20 games or more for nine consecutive seasons.
- The string of four straight 20-win seasons marks the first time in school history Tech has reached the plateau four seasons in a row.
- The Red Raiders had four players average at least 11.3 points last season, the only team in the Big 12 to accomplish the feat. Two of those players return in 2005-06.
- Sophomore guard **Martin Zeno** finished sixth in the Big 12 among freshman scorers last year with 12.5 points per game. He had 24 double-figure scoring efforts in 2004-05.
- Junior guard **Jarrius Jackson** is Tech's top returning scorer after posting 15.3 points per game last season. He scored 20 points or more eight times.
- Texas Tech has won 41 of 49 non-conference games over the past four years.
