Outlook

Coach Wayne Morgan inherited an ISU program in a state of flux prior to 2003-04 and took the Cyclones to the semifinals of the Postseason NIT.

Expectation levels remain solid for the upcoming campaign after the Cyclones finished 20-13 overall with postseason play and the most conference victories (seven) since the 2001 Big 12 championship season.

Iowa State loses a couple of key seniors from last winter's team, which defeated eventual NCAA Sweet 16 teams Xavier (Ohio), Kansas and Texas. Center Jackson Vroman (Big 12 rebounding leader with a 9.6 average) and guard Jake Sullivan (1,810 points—seventh in school career history) leave some large holes in the roster.

Bronx, N.Y. resident Curtis Stinson helps take up some of that slack after setting a Big 12 freshman mark for points scored with 534. The 6-2 guard and 2004 Big 12 Freshman of the Year also was among the Top Five in scoring (16.2 ppg), assists (4.3 average) and steals (1.7 average). Senior forward Jared Homan brings back 11.1 points per game and is a defensive force inside while third returning starter Will Blalock averaged 7.5 ppg and 4.1 apg as a freshman for the Cyclones.

ISU boasts one of the most talented young backcourts in the Big 12 and hopes to add depth behind the 6-9 Homan and 6-8 senior Damion Staple on the front line. Surprises such as 2003-04 three-point shooting ace 6-4 guard John Neal also return and bolster the chances for another 20-win campaign—best since the Cyclones finished 25-6 in 2000-01.

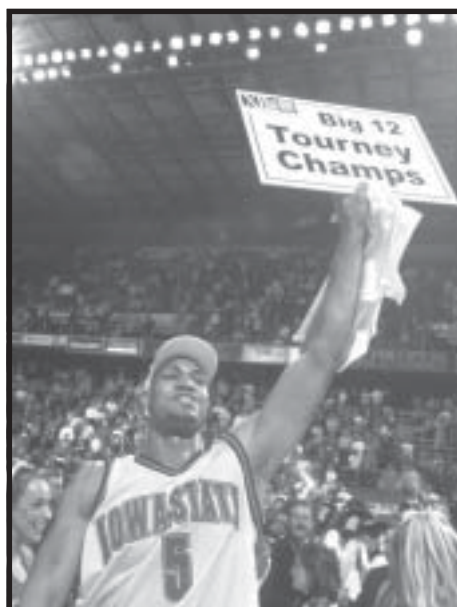

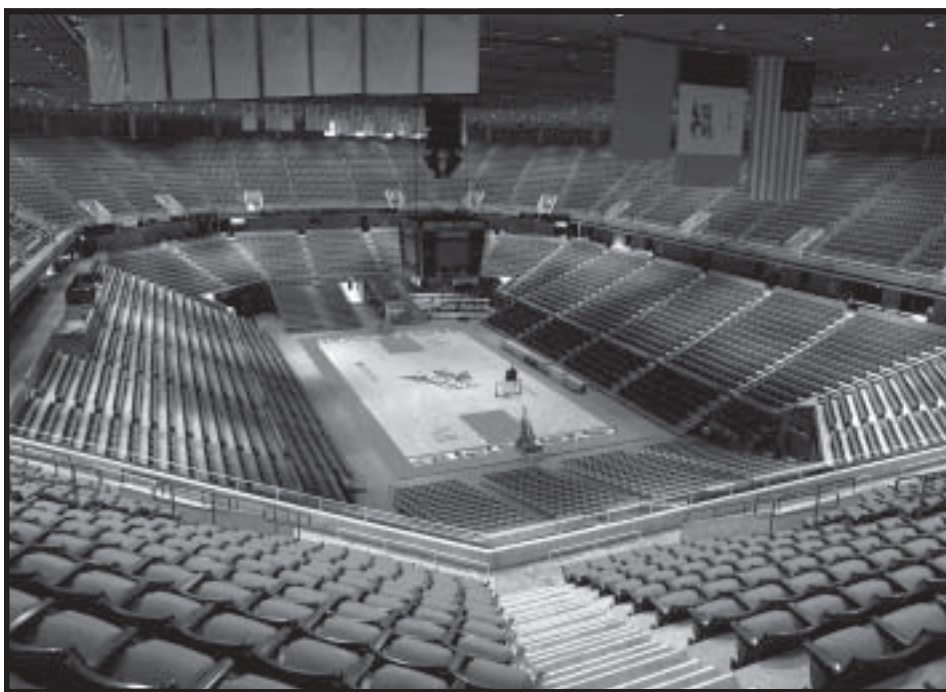

Outlook

From a No. 1 national ranking (AP) to untimely team injuries to tough mid-campaign road losses to a trip to the NCAA Elite Eight, Kansas basketball comes off an eventful 24-9 season with renewed toughness for 2004-05.

Last season's lessons translated into a steeling process for one of the nation's top senior classes, four returning starters, a national-class recruiting crop, and always-NCAA-competitive head coach Bill Self.

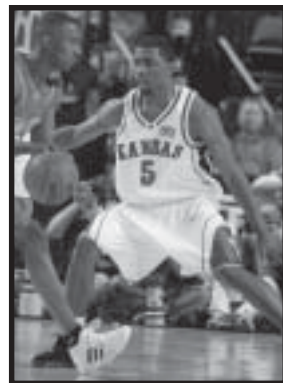
KU expects to be deep enough to play nine men consistently, according to Self, and the seasoned senior class has a 12-3 record in 15 previous NCAA encounters.

Guards Keith Langford (fellow Wooden Award nominee) and steady Aaron Miles (108 career starts, 33.8 minutes per game, 738 career assists, needs 65 to set school career mark) compliment multi-talented 6-5 wing J.R. Giddens (29 starts and an 11.3 scoring average as a freshman).

Physical Michael Lee (5.5 ppg, 2.5 rpg, though missing nine games with a broken collarbone) will be pushed by 6-1 freshman Russell Robinson and returning lettermen Jeff Hawkins, Stephen Bahe and Nick Bahe at guard.

Signees 6-11 Sasha Kaun, 6-10 C.J. Giles, power forward 6-8 Darnell Jackson, 6-10 Matt Kleinmann, and 6-7 Alex Galindo present immediate help in the front court as the Jayhawks vie for a school- and Big 12-record 16th consecutive trek to the NCAA tournament.

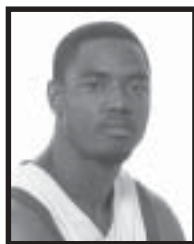
