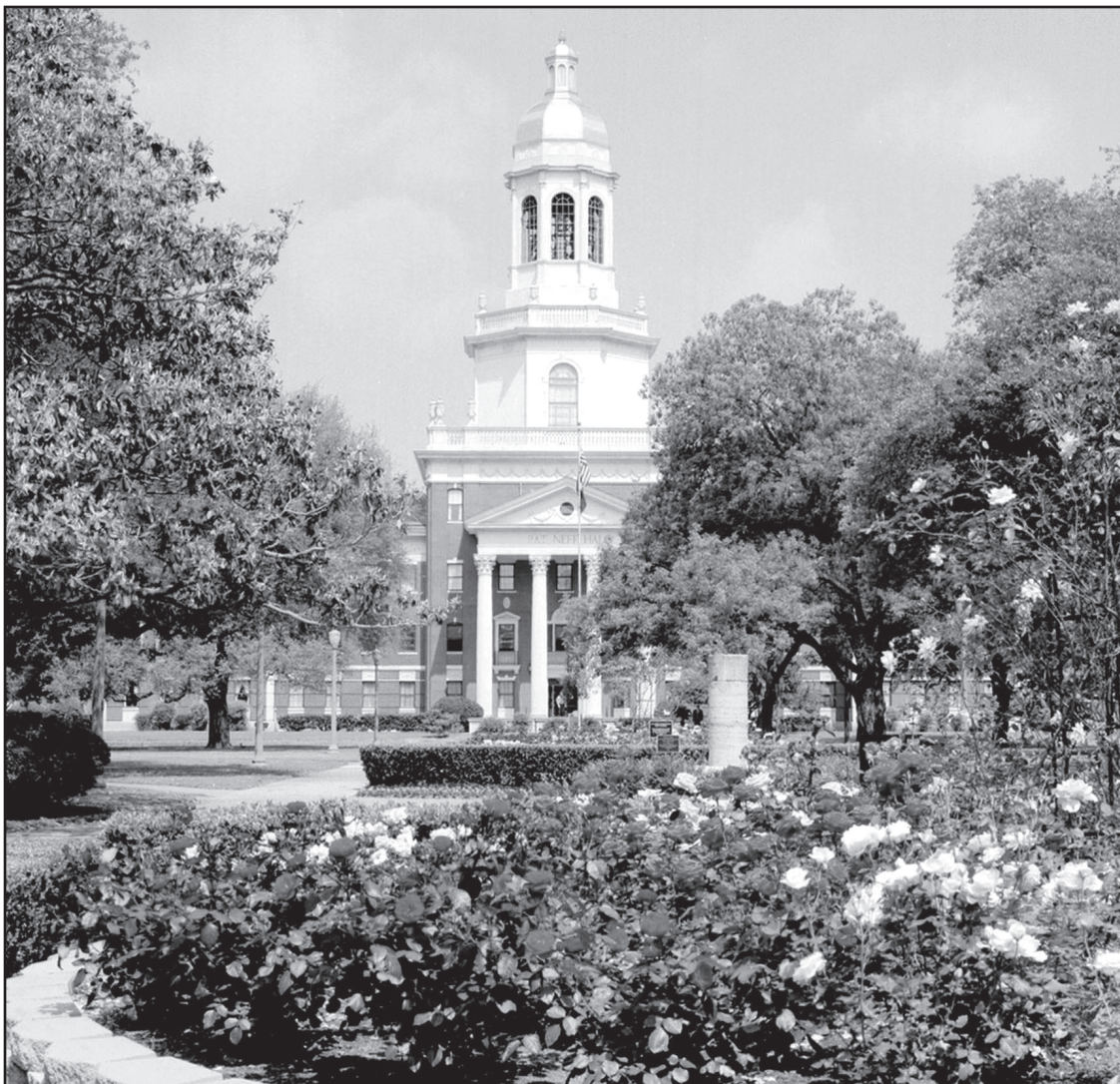

**Coaching Achievements:** Led Baylor to the Big 12's first basketball national title (men's or women's) in 2005 with a 33-3 mark; Became the first person in women's basketball history to win a national championship as both a player (Louisiana Tech) and head coach, and only the third person to accomplish this feat in both men's and women's basketball; Also won the '05 Big 12 regular season and championship titles en route to her first Big 12 Coach of the Year honor; Turned around the Baylor fortunes in her seven years leading the Lady Bears to seven postseason appearances, including all six of the school's NCAA Tournament appearances; During her 19-year tenure at Louisiana Tech as both a player and coach was associated with 11 Final Four squads and three national championship teams; Has played or coached in the national championship game on seven occasions; While an assistant coach, helped lead the Lady Techsters to a 430-68 record and seven Final Fours; A member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, CoSIDA Academic All-America Hall of Fame, National High School Hall of Fame, Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame, and Louisiana Tech Athletics Hall of Fame.

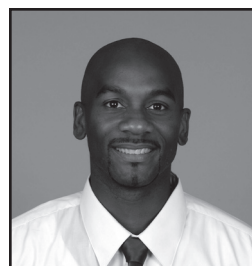

The Lady Bears return 73.5 percent of their scoring, 74.9 percent of rebounding and 79.1 percent of blocked shots from 2006-07.

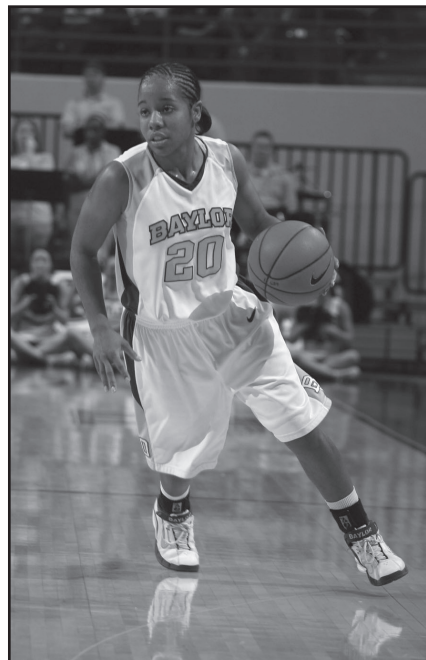
Nine letterwinners, including four starters (Allison, Morrow, Player, Tisdale) are back from last year's NCAA Tournament team.

Baylor's 12-player roster features only one senior (Tisdale) with four juniors, five sophomores and two freshmen.

Coach Kim Mulkey has led BU to seven-straight 20-win seasons and seven-consecutive postseason appearances.

The Lady Bears led the nation in blocked shots last season with 244 for a 7.2 per game average.

Baylor placed among the top four in the Big 12 standings for the fifth time in Mulkey's seven seasons.

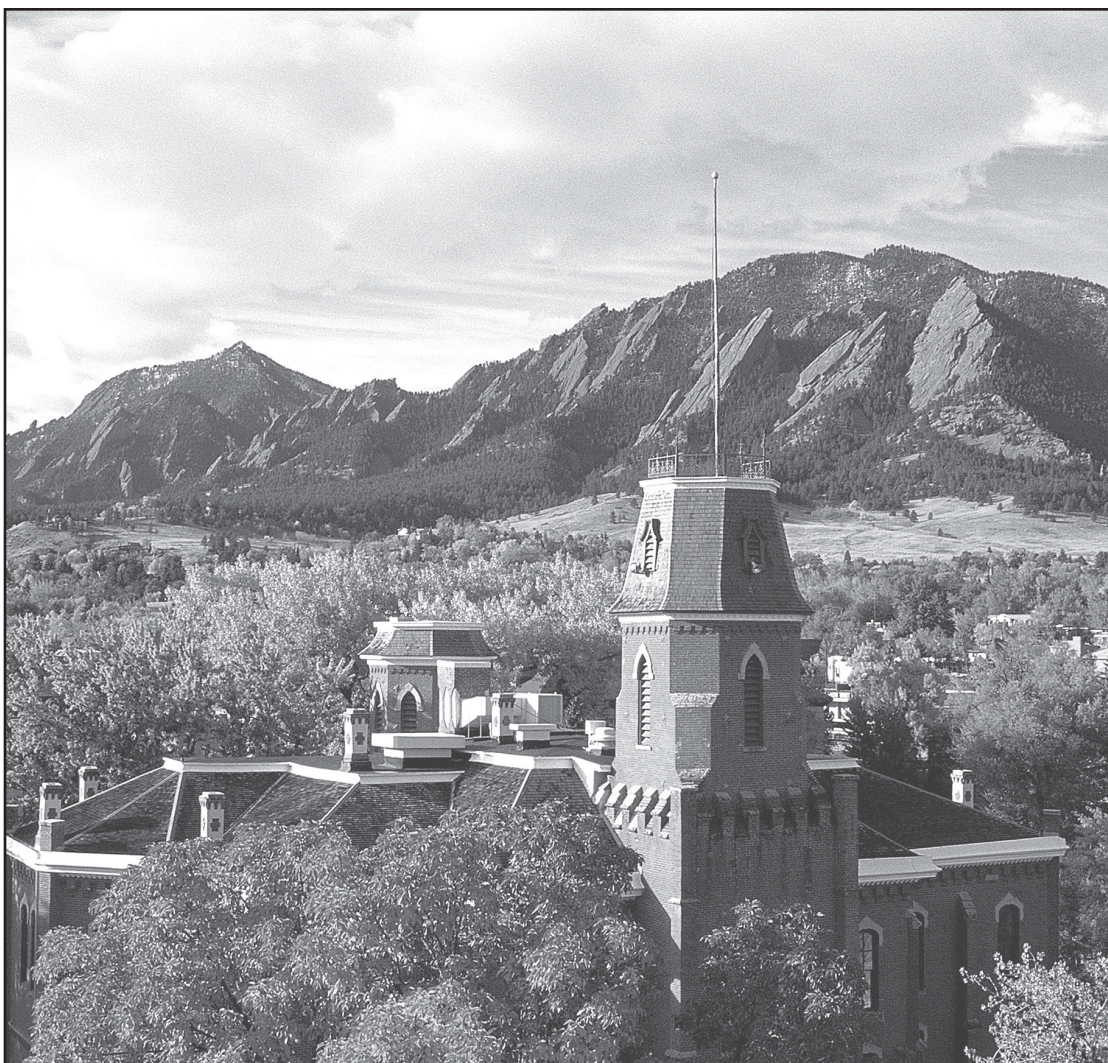

Colorado improved from 11th to a tie for seventh in the Big 12 last season while advancing to the second round of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship.

The Buffs bring back four starters to their 2007-08 squad (McFarland, Richards, Powers, Houston), along with six newcomers.

In addition, three others with starting experience return to the squad.

McFarland was a 2007 AP All-America honorable mention and first team All-Big 12 Conference selection. She ranked third in the NCAA and topped the Big 12 in field goal percentage with a .605 (181-299).

During the 2006-07 season, McFarland became the fifth player in team history with 1,300 career points and 700 career rebounds while earning ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America second team honors.

Colorado went 11-5 at home last season, including a 5-3 record against Big 12 opponents.

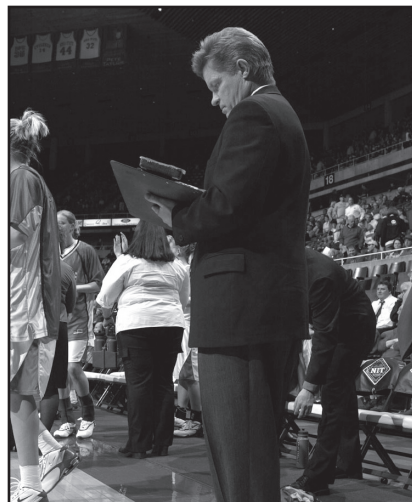

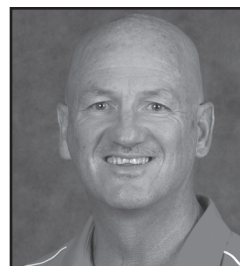

Iowa State advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament last season, its 10th postseason appearance under coach Bill Fennelly.

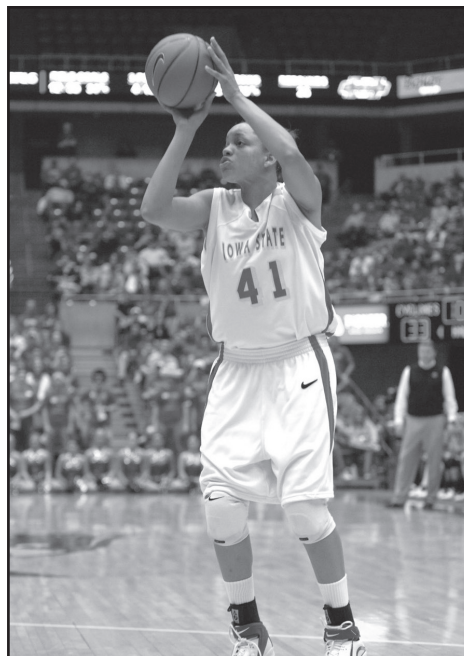
The 2006-07 Cyclones became the fourth team in Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship history to play on the first day and advance to the championship game.
