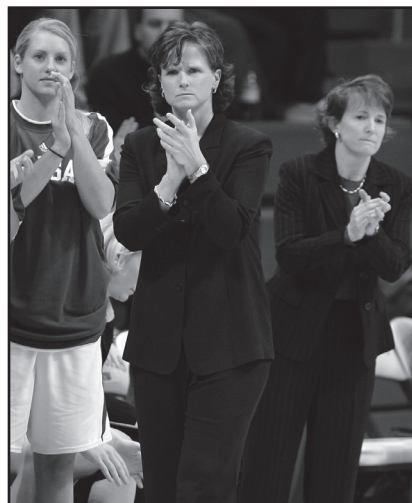

Kansas traveled to Australia this past August and finished the 10-day tour with a 3-1 record.

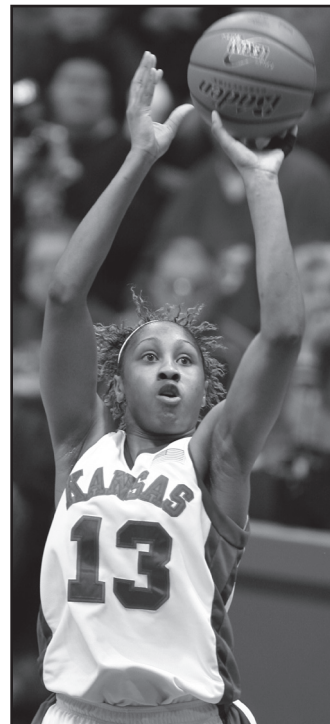
The young Jayhawks have only two seniors and two juniors on their squad of 14. Half of the roster is compiled of sophomores.

Senior forward Taylor McIntosh has started 87 of 89 games during her career. She led the squad in rebounding last season with 6.0 per game while contributing 6.8 ppg.

Sophomore Danielle McCray is KU's leading returning scorer with 10.5 points a year ago.

Guard Kelly Kohn started every game as a freshman in 2006-07 with averages of 9.8 ppg and 3.3 rpg.

Nine returners drew a starting assignment last season, including five who started at least 10 games.

Kansas State advanced to the semi-finals of the 2007 WNIT after winning the 2006 WNIT championship.

The Wildcats return six players that started at least 15 games and eight letterwinners from the 2006-07 squad.

Of the returners, three averaged double figure scoring last season and five averaged over seven points a game.

Senior Kimberly Dietz led the team in scoring last year with 13.3 ppg and was one of only two players (Shalee Lehning) to start all 34 contests.

Junior forward Marlies Gipson returns to the fold this season after missing the final 16 games with an injury last year. She led the team in rebounding with 8.3 per game and was second in scoring with 12.8 per outing.

Last season's leader in every statistical category, except steals and field goals made, returns for K-State.

More than 80 percent of KSU's total scoring and 87 percent of its rebounding will be back in 2007-08.

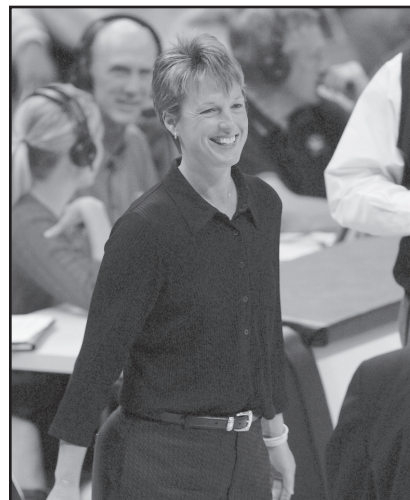

Missouri played in the 2007 WNIT, its second consecutive postseason appearance and seventh in the last eight years.

Cindy Stein has guided MU to postseason appearances in seven of her nine seasons, including three NCAA Tournaments.

The Tigers must replace four starters, including their top two scorers from last season.

Junior guard Alyssa Hollins is the squad's lone returning starter. She was third on the team in scoring in 2007 with 11.5 ppg while averaging 3.0 rpg.

Hollins started 30 of 31 games last year, including all 16 in Big 12 play.

MU fields a teams with no seniors in 2007-08. Hollins joins K-Kay Pickens as the only juniors to go along with four sophomores and five freshmen.
