

## Nebraska Cornhuskers

Last season, Nebraska made its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2000 and finished in the top four of the Big 12 standings for the first time since 1998.

The 2006-07 squad also won 20 games for the first time since 1999.

Connie Yori has led the Huskers to a postseason appearance four consecutive years in her five seasons.

NU used the same starting lineup in all 32 games last year.

The Huskers return only one starter this season in junior forward Kelsey Griffin who registered 15.0 points and 8.3 rebounds a year ago.

Nebraska has one senior on its 2007-08 roster (Danielle Page) to go along with two juniors, five sophomores and five freshmen.

## **Oklahoma Sooners**

Oklahoma tied for the Big 12 regular season title and won the postseason championship in 2006. The regular season crown was OU's second straight and fifth overall while the tournament title was also its second straight and fourth overall.

The Sooners played in the NCAA Tournament for the eighth consecutive year and advanced to the program's sixth Sweet 16.

Center Courtney Paris ended her sophomore season as a consensus All-American for the second consecutive year. She heads into her junior campaign with 1,563 career points and 1,065 career rebounds.

Paris has registered a double-double in a Big 12-record 61 straight games and scored double-figures in 69 straight.

OU returns three starters and five other letterwinners to its 2007-08 squad with the addition of four newcomers.




