

Gail Goestenkors becomes just the third coach in UT women's basketball history, replacing Jody Conradt, a Naismith and Women's Basketball Hall of Famer.

Goestenkors was 396-99 in 15 years at Duke, her first head coaching position. Her teams made 13 straight NCAA Tournament appearances and played in four Final Fours.

Texas returns four starters, but lost All-American and leading scorer (16.9 ppg) and rebounder (9.0 rpg) Tiffany Jackson.

Earnesia Williams is the team's top returning scorer with 9.5 ppg. Erika Arriaran averaged 10.5 ppg before being sidelined after 15 games with an ACL injury. Arriaran is expected to return this season.

The Longhorns return 69.6 percent of their points, 67.3 percent of their rebounds and 79.1 percent of assists production from last season.

UT is tied for No. 2 in all-time Big 12 Conference regular season victories with a 110-66 record in 11 seasons.

Texas A&M returns the same five starters for the second consecutive year to a squad that won the school's first Big 12 Championship and played in two NCAA Tournaments.

TAMU has made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in program history.

Gary Blair was named 2007 Big 12 Coach of the Year and four Aggie players were recognized on All-Big 12 squads.

A&M's 25 victories in 2006-07 marked the second-most in school annals behind the 26 recorded in 1979.

Associate Head Coach Vic Schaefer guided the U.S. Jones Cup Team to a bronze medal this past summer with a squad that featured six Big 12 players.

The A&M program is one victory shy of recording the 500th all-time win in school history.

Texas Tech has finished in the top four nationally in home attendance every year since the inception of the Big 12. The program ranked third last year, averaging over 10,000 fans per game.

TTU's 124 wins in Big 12 play are a league-best.

The Lady Raiders' top returning scorer is sophomore Jordan Murphree with 9.1 ppg. She led the team in assists last year with 3.0 per game.

Texas Tech welcomes nine newcomers to its team, all of whom are sophomore or junior transfers. The squad has no freshmen on its roster and just two seniors.

Departed senior Alesha Robertson was the only Lady Raider to average in double figures last year with 13.2 ppg. Six other players averaged at least six points per contest.

Texas Tech has made 18 NCAA Tournament appearances and compiled a record of 30-17 (.638). The 30 NCAA wins rank second among Big 12 teams behind Texas' 31.
